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# Take the ACT

- **Juniors take the ACT at CCC in February**
- □Sign up for and take the ACT again during second semester.
- Go online to www.actstudent.org to sign up.
- □See your counselor if you are eligible for a Fee Waiver.

# **Begin to Research Colleges**

- 1. Use the Naviance website to do college searches based on interests/profile.
- 2. Use Naviance to find information on college rep visits to CCC.
- 3. During Junior Jump-Start, students begin to develop their college list on Naviance link "Colleges I'm Thinking About".
- 4. Use Naviance account to research colleges and update resume.

# Continue to strive to do your academic best

- 1. College admissions look at three main factors: GPA, coursework, and ACT score.
- 2. Junior year grades are important- upward trend/impact cumulative GPA.
- 3. Mid-year & final transcripts are sent to the colleges during senior year.
- 4. After-school tutoring is available.

Counselors meet individually with each junior in spring

- Course selections for senior year are discussed as well as ACT testing & plans for the future.
- Students submit to Guidance their student/parent questionnaire as well as a copy of their resume.

In the summer between 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade ...

- Visit college campuses.
- Do more college searches online.
- View college applications on college websites.
- Work on college application essays.

## Fall of Senior Year

- Attend Senior College Night in September (for student and parent).
- Counselors work with seniors through English class to update Naviance account, update resume, begin to list colleges on the link "Colleges I'm Applying To".
- Seniors meet with their counselor individually in September to finalize future plans, college list, decisions regarding retake of ACT.
- Apply to colleges by October 15<sup>th</sup>.

# Remember what is most important in college admissions

### Top three factors that "open the door":

- Grades
- **Test Scores**
- **Strength of Curriculum**

Next three factors that can help make the final decision:

- Essay
- Letters of recommendation
- **Extracurricular activities/leadership**
