In conclusion Mrs. Lind congratulated and thanked the teachers and parents for staying home or keeping their children home when they didn't feel well. She asked for their continued patience while the school experiences shortages in staffing.

Before leaving the meeting she announced the school board meeting on 11/12/2020 and invited all to attend.
