THE POSITION

The Wendell School District Board of Trustees is seeking a highly qualified, outstanding educational leader to serve as superintendent.

THE DISTRICT AT-A-GLANCE

Student Enrollment: 1,120

Staff: 141 (Administrators 3, Certified Staff 73, Classified Staff 68)

Budget: \$10.1 million

Schools: 1 Elementary school, 1 Middle school and 1 High school

The district has one remaining bond on the elementary school that will payoff in 2030. The district also has one supplemental levy that is ran every two years for \$600,000 per year, to meet the district's projected fiscal needs. The district has a strong and experienced teaching staff, a dedicated administrative team, an outstanding district office staff, and exceptional support personnel, including a forward thinking IT department.

Our district is located in the "HUB CITY" of the Magic Valley. The population is around 3,000 residents. Wendell has a small town atmosphere with a close knit community.

While Wendell itself is relatively small, its location offers access to outdoor activities in the surrounding region, including hiking, fishing, and other recreational pursuits in the nearby Snake River and other natural areas.

- Strong instructional leader with effective communication skills, budgetary experience, and a passion for students.
- Shows respect, transparency, good judgement, and integrity in relationships with Trustees, administrators, teachers, parents, students and community.

- Leads by example and understands the differences between leadership and management with skilled and proven abilities in both areas.
- Ready and able to chart the course for the next exciting chapter of the district by taking a creative and innovative approach to education by minimizing budgetary constraints while maximizing educational opportunities.
