KPTA meeting led by Elaine Simadis, Ambassador

Fr. Tom opened with Prayer.

The meeting was called to order by Elaine Simadis.

Elaine then provided the results of the parent survey that took place the previous week relating to the projects the available KPTA funds would be allocated to. 91 parents voted and the results were as follows:

- 1. Update WIFI in the building \$4,000
- 2. Add security measures to the main school interior entrance doors \$4,448
- 3. Add security key pad access to the school and church doors \$5,149

Work would commence as soon as possible on the new projects. Elaine reminded the group that the prior year KPTA had voted to fund a \$200 reimbursement per teacher to begin the school year and \$400 for new gym equipment.

Elaine then reviewed the KPTA Guidelines and the nomination process. It was explained that, as per the guidelines, the 2020-2021 KPTA must have a Board of four officers at all times. The Board consists of President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. Elaine explained that each officer position needs a first and second nomination before it can be accepted. It was further explained that if there was more than one nominee for any officer position an electronic vote would take place. The electronic vote would be open for 5 days and the winner would be presented at a meeting to take place in one week. The winner would be determined by majority vote.

Elaine opened the floor for nominations for the 2020-2021 KPTA

- 1. Ted Cachampis nominated Cherie Cachampis for Secretary with a second from Georgia Shizas Cherie accepted the nomination
- 2. Evy Marouda nominated Natasha Pytlewski for Secretary with a second from Connie Cassiani Natasha accepted the nomination
- 3. Valentino Marouda nominated Connie Cassiani for Vice President with a second from Maria Deitelhoff – Connie accepted the nomination
- 4. Evy Marouda nominated Georgia Shizas for President with a second from Anna Girgis, Connie Cassiani and Natassa Pytlewski Georgia accepted the nomination

Discussion within the group ensued and Natasha Pytlewski moved from Secretary to Treasurer. Natasha accepted.

Elaine congratulated the new board.
