**LEARNING CHARACTERISTICS**

- 1. Has unusually advanced vocabulary for age or grade level;
- 2. Grasps concepts quickly, easily, without much repetition; may be bored with routine tasks; may dislike rote homework;
- 3. Is a keen and alert observer, usually "Sees more" or "Gets more" out of a movie, video, etc., than others;
- 4. Reasons things out for himself/herself; sees logical and common sense answers.

**MOTIVATIONAL CHARACTERISTICS**

- 1. Has intense, often diverse, self-directed interests (may be difficult to get him/her to move to another topic);
- 2. Strives toward perfection; is self-critical; is not easily satisfied with his/her own speed or products;
- 3. Prefers to work independently; may be highly individualistic; requires little direction from teachers;
- 4. Often is self-assertive (sometimes even aggressive); stubborn in his/her beliefs.

**LEADERSHIP CHARACTERISTICS**

- 1. Carries responsibilities well; can be counted on to do what he/she has promised and usually does it well;
- 2. Adapts readily to new situations; is flexible in thought and actions; is not disturbed when the normal routine is changed;
- 3. Takes intellectual and emotional risks in expressing or trying out ideas; is self-confident with children his/her age as well as adults;
- 4. Generally directs the activity in which he/she is involved.

**CREATIVE CHARACTERISTICS**

- 1. Enthusiastically generates ideas or solutions to problems and questions; offers unusual, unique, clever responses (may dominate others because of his/her abilities);
- 2. Is curious; asks more provocative questions about the causes and reasons for things;
- 3. Displays a keen sense of humor and sees humor in situations that may not appear to be humorous to others (may make jokes at inappropriate times);
- 4. Uses imagination and fantasy in problem solving situations (i.e. imaginary play mates; inventing cures for diseases, poverty, or energy crisis; intellectual playfulness).
