Quail Run Elementary School Named National Blue Ribbon School

HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – Quail Run Elementary School has been named a 2023 National Blue Ribbon School by the U.S. Department of Education. Miguel Cardona, the U.S. Secretary of Education, made the announcement on September 19. The U.S. Department of Education chose 353 schools for this national award. Located in Warner Robins, Quail Run Elementary is one of eight schools chosen in Georgia. Dr. Amanda Miliner serves as principal.

According to the U.S. Department of Education, the National Blue Ribbon School award affirms and validates the hard work of



students, educators, families, and communities in attaining exemplary achievement. National Blue Ribbon Schools serve as models of effective school practices for state and district educators throughout the nation. A National Blue Ribbon School flag gracing a school's entryway is a widely recognized symbol of exemplary teaching and learning.

Quail Run Elementary School was recognized as an Exemplary High Performing School.
