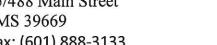

Purpose

Wilkinson County School District (WCSD) recognizes the importance of administering and scoring of psychological test batteries evaluating cognitive, academic, psycho-educational, and behavioral status, in order to assist the School Psychologists and other special education personnel in the Child Find process. The candidate will also administer standardized testing appropriate to determine school placement, disability categories, and other Child Find decisions.

This Request for Proposal (RFP) is seeking highly qualified providers/agencies to provide the following services to WCSD students:

- Administer and score psychological tests as defined by Mississippi Department of Education (MDE).
- Assist with special groups such gifted testing, speech screeners, early intervention, and head start testing.
- Process referrals and re-evaluations, perform observations, and administer evaluation instruments to individual students.
- Maintain accurate records and other required data, prepare, and submit reports in a timely manner.

Scope of Proposal

Psychometrist services provided to WCSD students in school should be based on the following principles and guidelines:

- Services will be provided by licensed professionals with a valid Mississippi Department of Education License with a Psychometrist Endorsement (213)
- Excellent oral and written communication skills with the ability to foster positive working relationships.
- Must have strong organizational, problem-solving, and time-management skills.
- Service provider's should be willing to build collaborations with school administrators, student services, support staff, teachers, and other school staff.
- Must be able to travel between schools and the central office as required as a condition of the proposal.

Eligible Proposal Format

Section A. Introduction (3 pages max)

- Describe why you believe that your organization, from a business, professional, clinical, administrative, financial, and technical perspective, should be awarded an agreement for the services requested. Describe aby distinguishing features WCSD should know about your services and company and provide an overview of your proposal.
- Generally, describe what you propose to do under the scope of services.
- Please provide the consultant's name if your organization uses an outside consultant to assist with the RFP.

Section B. Organizational Background and Expertise (5 pages max)

For this RFP, describe your background and expertise in the following:

- 1. How long have you provided Psychometrist services to children?
- 2. Provide a detailed implementation plan, including a timeline, for the services requested.
- 3. Describe how you will address each of the required elements listed in the Scope of Proposal.

Section C. Quote for Services

Please provide your rate for providing services to individual students (please include mileage and assessments as well).

The services will be rendered for the entire 2024-2025 school year.

Proposal Evaluation

Proposals will be pre-screened to ensure the organization (i) meets the minimum qualifications, (ii) has completed all material sections of the RFP, and (iii) is responsive to the questions. Once a Proposal passes the pre-screen process, it will be reviewed by a Selection Committee designated by WCSD, which may include WCSD staff, school board members, and other stakeholders deemed needed. The top vendor will be selected. An interview process may be utilized to gain additional information and pose questions to providers. Reviewing the proposal will include the extent to which the Proposal meets the stated requirements as set out in this RFP as well as the applicants' stability, experience, and record of past performance in delivering such services.

- WCSD reserves the right to reject any proposals for any reason, including but not limited to false information in the proposal and discovered by WCSD.
