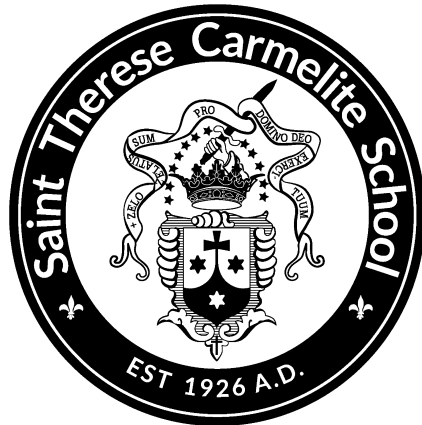

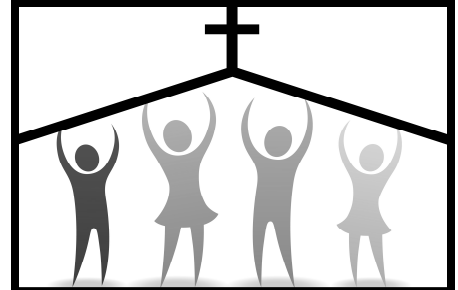

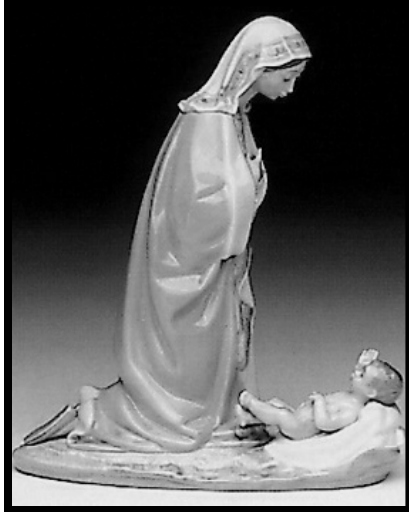
We are looking for volunteers from 8th Grade on up, including adults. We will do planning and make station assignments

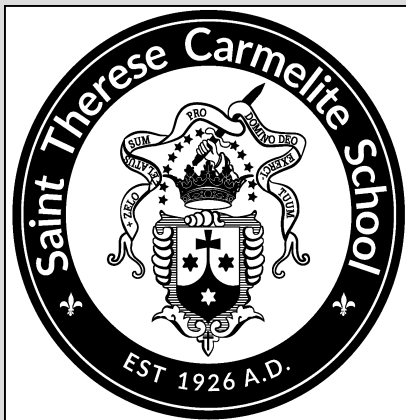

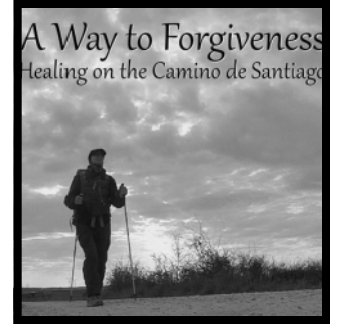
