**Special Reports:**

- Teacher Presentations: Misty Blais, Title I; Ann Gray, Library Media
- Misty Blais shared results of the AIMS-Web assessments which demonstrates significant student growth in reading and mathematics for our elementary students... Ms. Blais discussed the School Improvement Plan and how it tied to the assessment data. We are using data to monitor student progress, determine student needs and drive instruction. Intervention is provided during class time and flex time. She also noted that the school would be implementing a new reading series in the fall thanks to grant funds. Title I services are provided K-6. Ms. Blais also coordinates student assessments in the elementary grades. We are planning a literacy night in May to invite families into our school to learn more about our student reading and writing progress and how parents can support reading and partner with our schools.
- Ann Gray shared books that the students developed. Students were very interested and engaged in the work. She went on to share information on research projects that the students are working on beginning in kindergarten.
