Screenings

Vision and hearing screenings will be conducted during the school year. If you do not wish your child to participate, please call or send a note to the school nurse.

Lice

The nurse is always on the lookout for lice. Please take the time to check your student's hair for these little insects. Contact the nurse for information about lice and how to rid your family of them. They do not fly or jump. They crawl. They cannot live more than 24-48 hours without a host. They feed on human blood. Your student is most likely to get lice when sleeping overnight at someone's house or sharing hair brushes. Pets do not get or carry human head lice. Signs to watch for: Itching, Nits, Visible Lice. Parents should check their students head before or after any sleepovers or camps. Remember, it will take several weeks for signs of lice to become obvious.

Health Conditions

If your child has a change in their health, a new diagnosis or a new medication, please notify the health office. We will add it onto their history.

Medication at School

Students are NOT allowed to carry any type of medication on them while at school. All medication must come through the Nurse's Office, brought in by the parent/guardian.

We continue to ask for help to keep everyone safe.

Homework requests are only made only if a student is absent two or more consecutive days. If you request homework, please make every effort to pick up the packets in a timely manner.

Reasons to see your school counselor:

- Have someone listen for a few minutes without judgement.
- Discuss friendships, exams, and stress from home.
- Take advantage of a quick vent session if needed.
- Counselors are advocates for students and can teach coping, study, and organization skills.
- ullet A counselor can help students through the steps of resolving a conflict.
