Administration Checklist of "Things to Do" Prior To and Following Each Game

WEEKS AND DAYS PRIOR TO GAME

_____1. Communicate the following stadium rules to all parents and fans through phone callout, social media, etc. – **SEND NOTIFICATIONS SEVERAL TIMES STARTING AT LEAST 2 WEEKS PRIOR TO EACH GAME.**

- A. No entry without proceeding through metal detectors at Main Gate
- B. No Passes Out. ABSOLUTELY NO RE-ENTRY FOR ANY REASON
- C. Clear bags only. **NO** backpacks of any kind allowed. Even clear bags are subject to search upon entry.
- D. No weapons or dangerous instruments of any kind allowed (guns, knives, pepper spray, etc.)
- E. No outside food or drink allowed
- F. No tobacco products, vapes, or E cigarettes allowed
- G. No spectator will be allowed to change sides of the stadium for any reason, i.e., no moving from home side to visitor side or vice versa
- H. MCPSS reserves the right to deny entry and/or remove anyone from sporting venues
- _____2. Ensure all necessary school staff members are in place for each required game day, job-related duty including but not limited to:
 - A. Validating GoFan tickets
 - B. Parking vehicles / directing traffic
 - C. Setting up / taking down metal detectors, barricades, and tables
 - D. Securing stadium prior to game and being available throughout game to unlock gates as needed
 - E. Administrator(s) present at Main Gate to vet fans for any person who should not be allowed entry

GAME DAY, PRIOR TO GAME

1. Ensure walkthrough metal detectors are charged and in place at Main Gate
2. Ensure metal barricades are in place at Main Gate
3. Ensure two (2) six (6) foot tables are present at Main Gate
4. Ensure 8 "shoebox size" plastic containers present at Main Gate
5. Ensure large Ziploc bags are present at Main Gate
6. Ensure 1 handheld metal detectors for each walkthrough metal detector at Main Gate
7. Ensure law enforcement officers are in place prior to gates opening
8. Ensure King Security officers are in place prior to gates opening

GAME DAY, FOLLOWING GAME
1. Ensure walk-through metal detectors are stored inside locked area and plugged in to charge
2. Ensure handheld metal detectors and containers are properly stored and available for next game
3. Ensure tables are securely stored inside the stadium and available for next game.
4. Ensure handheld radios are properly stored and charged for next game
5. Ensure all building doors inside stadium and all gates are properly closed and locked after all persons have exited
