Once again this fall, the Mustang Football program will be offering youth football to students in grades 4th, 5th, and 6th. The youth football program is a vital asset to our football program in general. The experience young athletes gain, especially the technical skills of the game that promote player safety, are invaluable to our overall program.

Our youth football program has always been full contact with full pads. We believe this is necessary in order to properly teach the techniques for not only player development but more importantly player safety specifically concussion prevention. As is the case at all levels of football, especially youth, a limited amount of full contact practice is important. Our practices focus on skills needed to be successful with controlled contact.

At this time we are planning to maintain a small number of competitive games against youth programs from other schools. At this time we plan on scheduling games against Bigfork, Littlefork, and other area teams.

As always youth coaches work very closely with our 'JH' team, JV, and Varsity coaches to ensure safety and program uniformity. As in any sport there is a risk of injury. We recommend that you have adequate insurance and have your young athlete get a sports physical.
