THE BOY'S VARSITY SOCCER TEAM COMPETED IN THE ALPENA HURON SHORES INVITATIONAL ON SATURDAY.

In the 1st game Tawas lost to Cheboygan 1-3. Goalkeeper Ethan Hedglin had 5 saves and allowed 3 goals.

In game 2 Tawas competed in a challenging game, scoring 1st against host Alpena at the 28th minute with a goal by Trace Reay assisted by Austin Baker. Seconds before the end of the 30 minute half Alpena tied the game back. In the second half the Braves played hard for 20 minutes of the 30 minute 2nd half then the Wildcats put on a rally and scored 3 goals in the remaining 10 minutes for a final score of 1-4. Goalkeeper Ethan Hedglin had 6 saves and allowed 5 goals.

In the 3rd game of the day Grayling scored a goal at the 23 minute mark putting them up 1 before the end of the 1st half. In the second half Tawas's Vinnie Frank scored 3 goals, 1 assisted by Gage Maxwell and 2 assists by Jake Look while Grayling put in 2 more goals to make the game a 3-3 tie at the end of regulation. The game went into a penalty shoot-out with the Vikings coming out on top completing 5 of 7 shots while Tawas was successful with 4 of their 7 shots. PK's were made by Vinnie Frank, Jake Look, Ethan Hedglin and Brant McKinley. Goalkeeper Ethan Hedglin had 4 saves, allowed 3 goals in regulation play and had 1 save in the PK shoot out.
