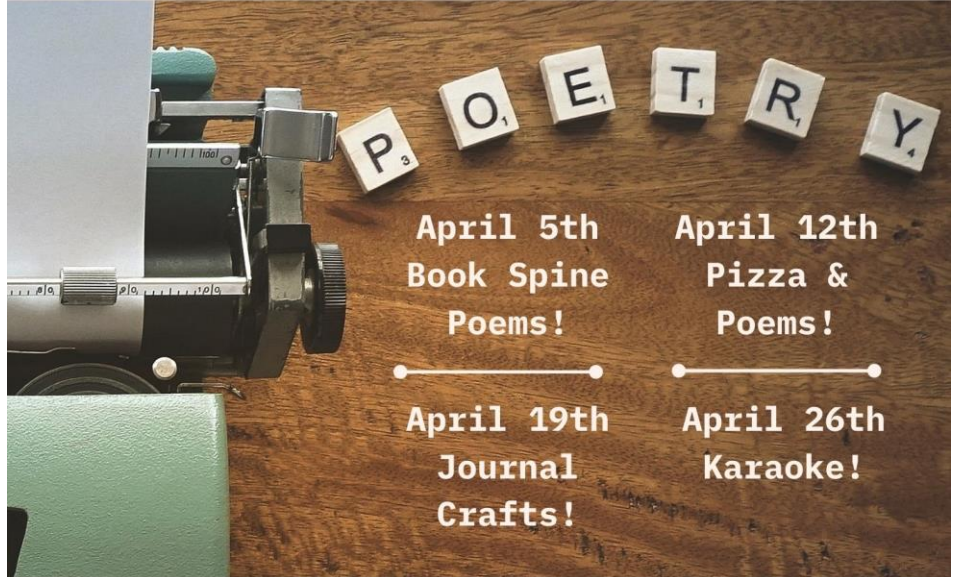
SEASIDE BUILDER'S CLUB

FBLA

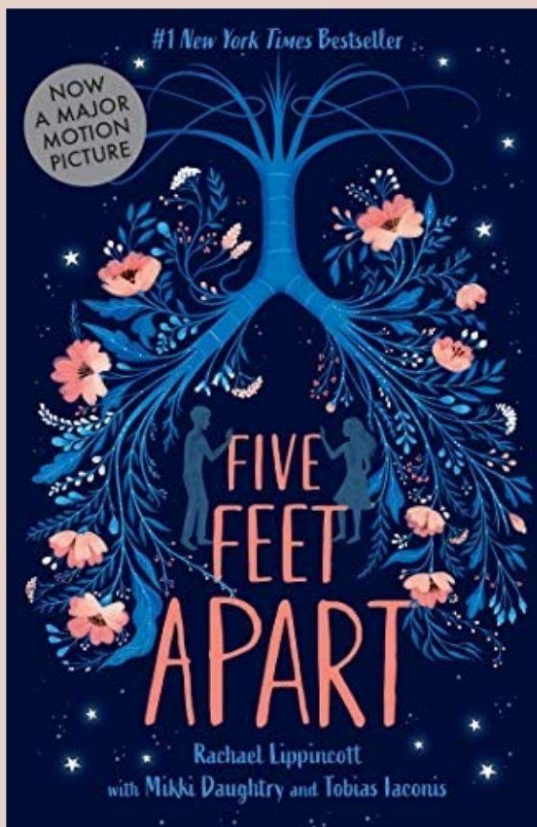

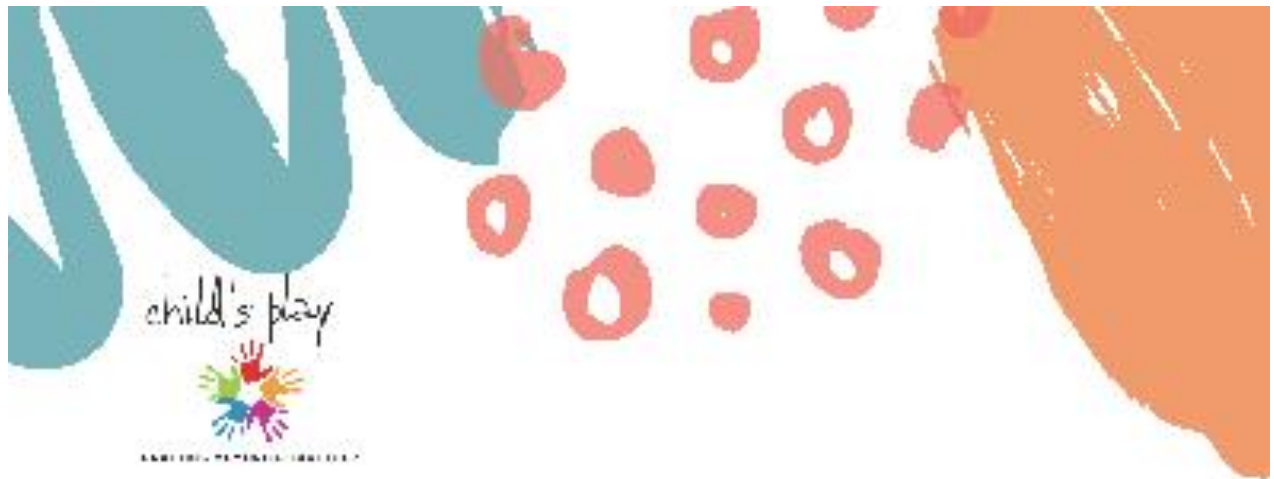
