

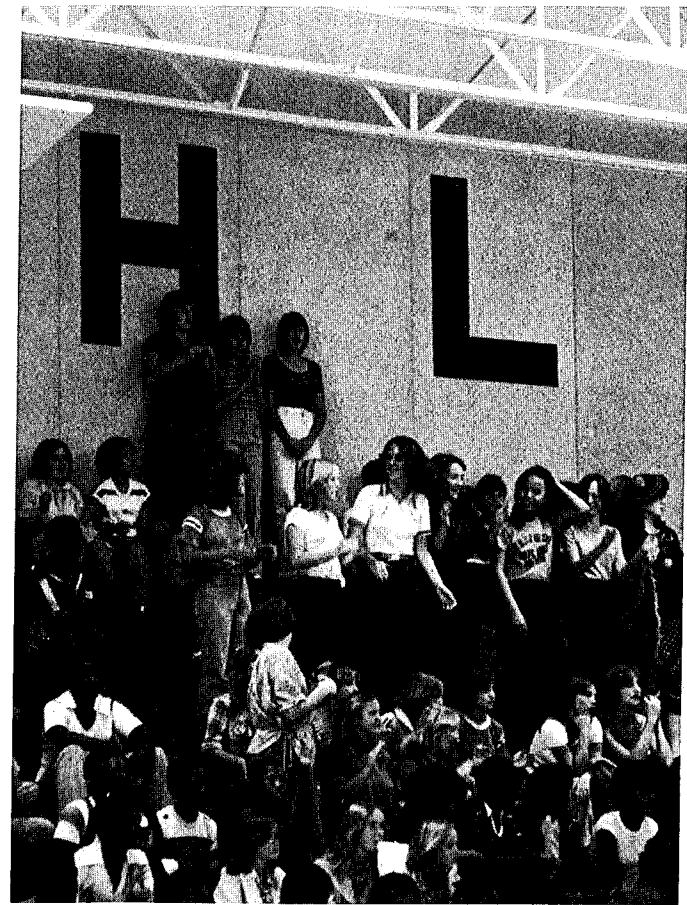
## Freshmen Explore With Spirit

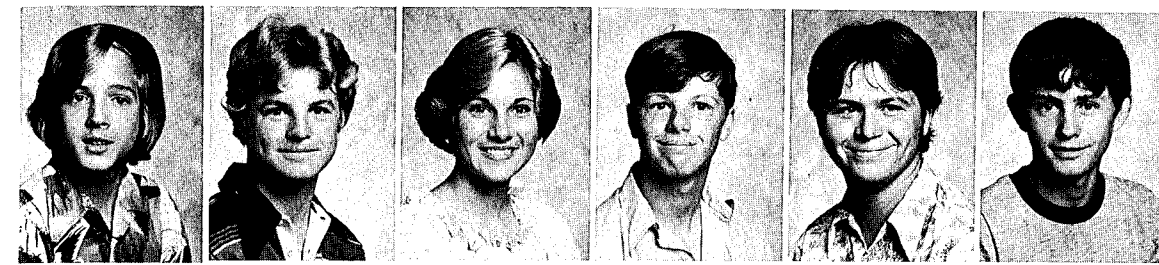
The freshmen selected Laura McGill and Pat Borders to represent them at the Homecoming activities.

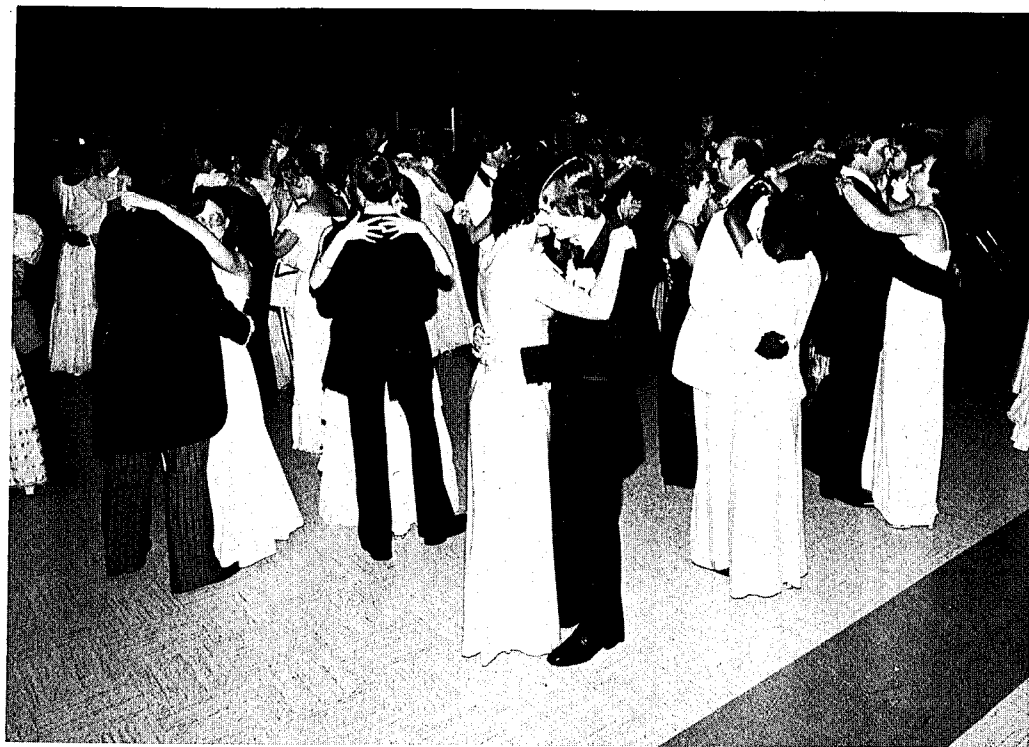
# Juniors Present an Old-Fashioned Prom for the Class of '79

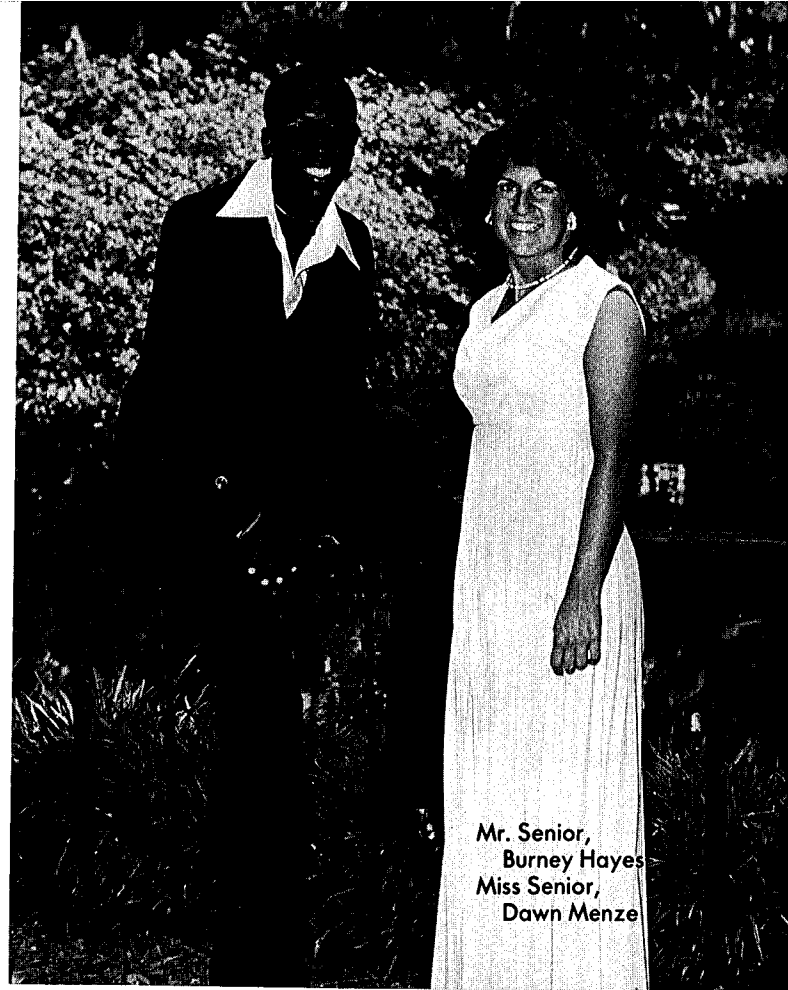


# Outstanding Seniors

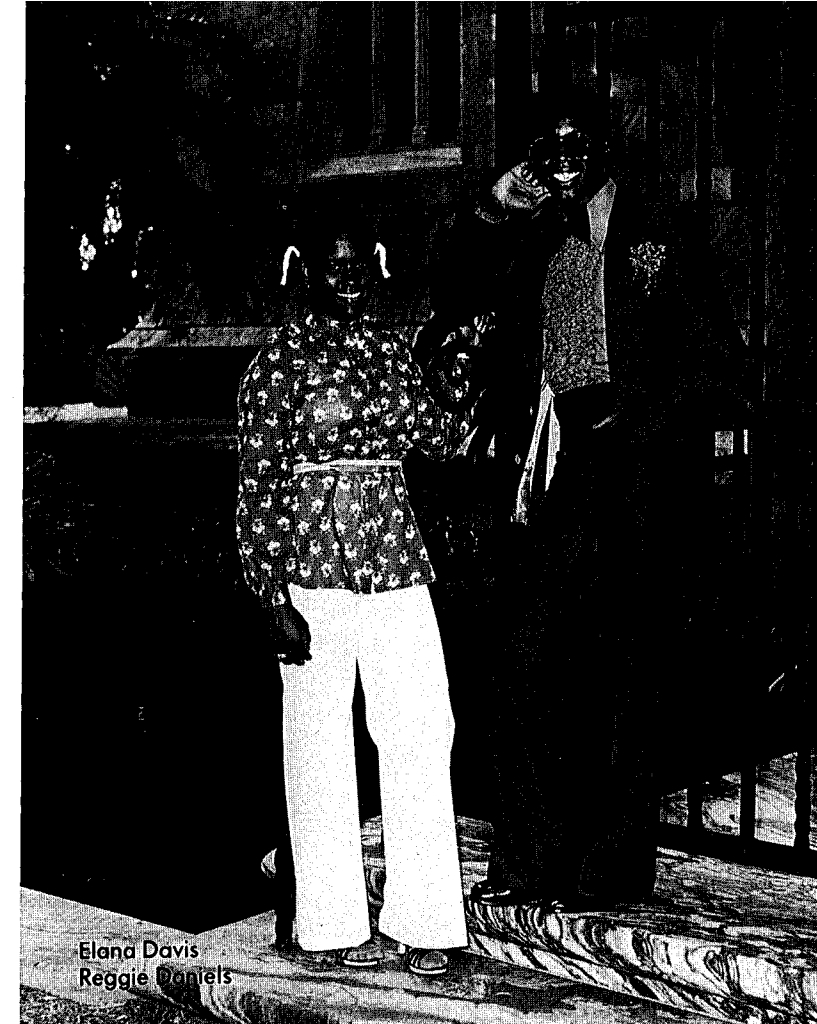

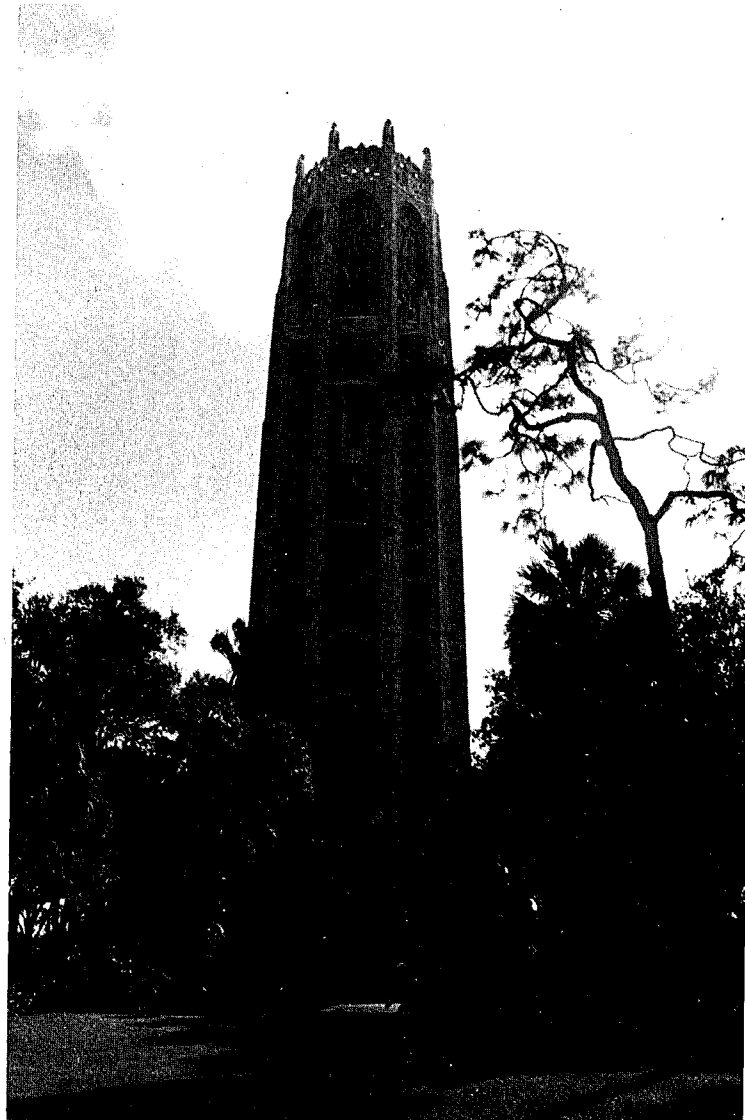
## Seniors Begin the Climb of Success

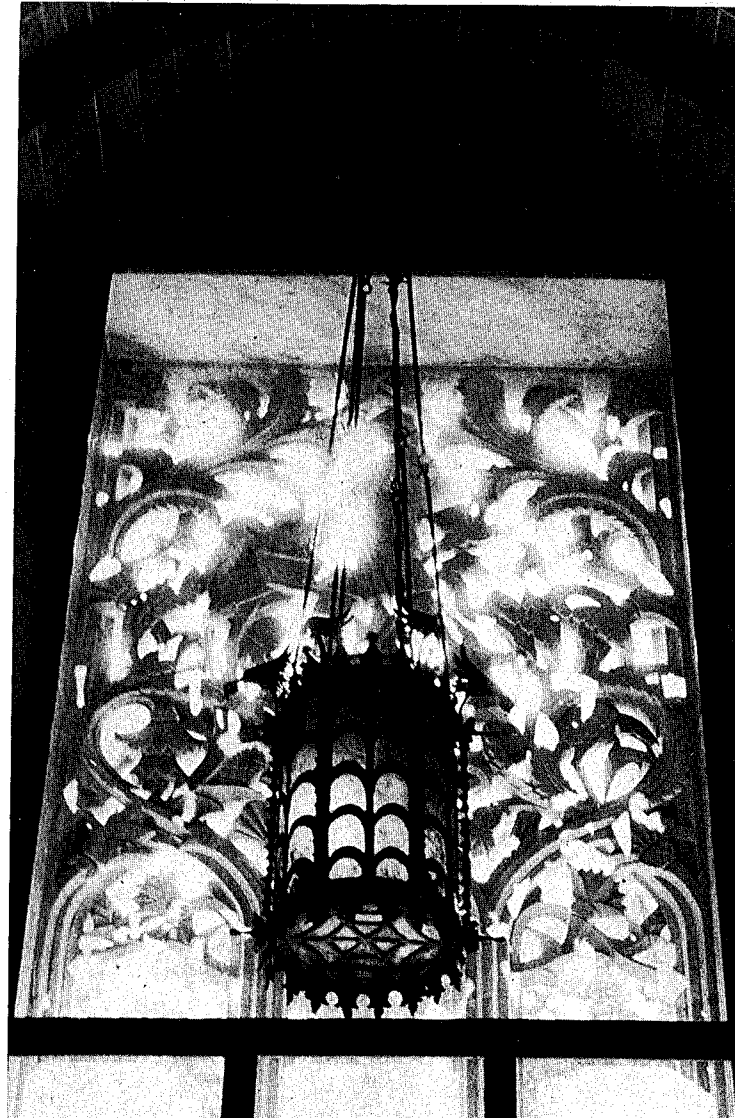

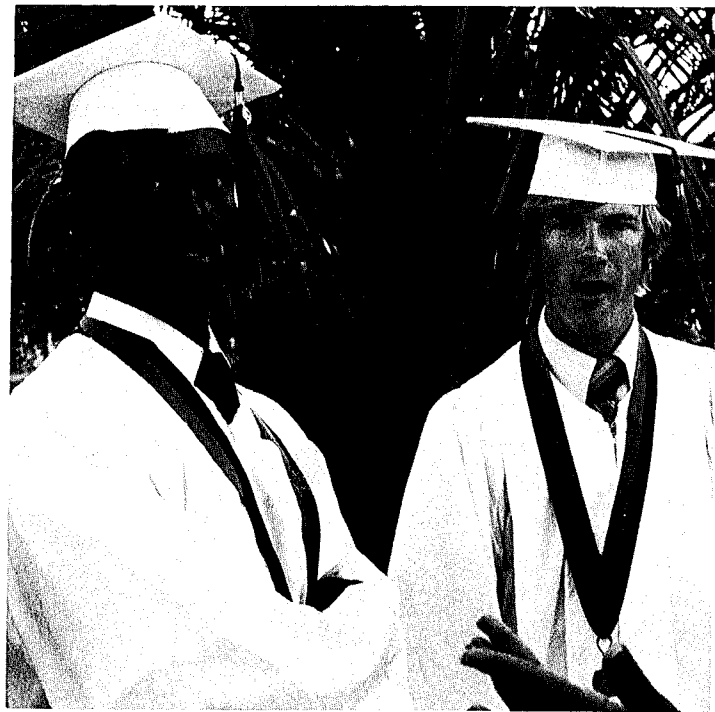


## Service Held in Honor of Seniors
