*Lice Policy*

Robinson Elementary School has established a NO NIT Policy for the students who attend the school. Students who are identified as having nits or live bugs will be sent to the nurse's station. Parent will be notified and asked to treat their child. Students will be sent home to be treated. Students will return to school no longer than two days later. Upon their return to school, students will be accompanied by a parent. Parent and child will report to the nurse's station. The child will be examined before returning to class. If nits are present, the parent will need to take the child home for additional treatment.

If a student has not returned in three days, a home visit will be made by the Resource Director or Principal. If the student continues to be absent after the home visit, The Principal will notify the DPP for a follow-up visit.

The school has established a team to examine students at our school.
