- Research and stay abreast of innovative and effective practices.
- Assist teachers in building interactive, engaging classroom environments rich with student dialogue.
- Engage the Learning Community in opportunities for individual discussion, coaching sessions, modeling with pre-and post-discussion, study groups, and data meetings.
- Prioritize support identified teachers; offer coaching, modeling, and co-planning instruction to improve teaching and learning (i.e., effective instructional strategies, interpretation of student data, creation and implementation of goals to improve student data).
- Support teachers in implementing the Alabama Course of Study (i.e., an overview of the standards, unpacking the standards, and differentiating instruction based on student data).
- Work with small groups of students to improve student achievement.
- Work with the school's identified MTSS Facilitator, EL Facilitator, Instructional Coach(es), Counselor, Teachers, and Principal to support effective instruction.
