Whereas, Glenn Howard, a 1977 alumnus, distinguished himself as a football player in Paulsboro High School, and

Whereas, Glenn Howard attended the University of Minnesota to earn his degree, and also distinguished himself as a football player, and

Whereas, Glenn Howard played football professionally as a linebacker for the Philadelphia - Baltimore Stars of the United States Football League, and

Whereas, Glenn Howard began his professional teaching career with Paulsboro Public Schools on December 1, 1986, and was head coach at his alma mater for 35 years, and

Whereas, Glenn Howard guided the Paulsboro Football Team in the 1990s where they won six consecutive sectional titles from 1992-1997, and produced a state-record 63-game winning streak, and

Whereas, Glenn Howard has officially ended one of the greatest coaching careers in state history, closing the book on a 35year run that included 316-70 record and guided the Paulsboro Football Team Red Raiders to 14 South Jersey Group 1 championships at his alma mater, and

Whereas, Glenn Howard guided the Paulsboro Football Team to a 37-game win streak that ended in 2003. Included in that streak were three unbeaten seasons 11-0 in 2000, 12-0 in 2001 and 12-0 in 2002.

Whereas, Glenn Howard over the years with the Paulsboros Football Program has had plenty of outstanding athletes, but the work ethic under Coach Howard was second to none. Long practices were the norm, and Coach Howard had his team prepared each and every week, and

Whereas Glenn Howards leadership, efforts and guidance with the Paulsboro Football Program is a success. We will now look to continue the incredible success of Paulsboro Football Program that has lasted for most of the past four and a half decades, and

Whereas, Glenn Howard retired in June 2022 as a Middle School Science Teacher, and Paulsboro Football Program Head Coach, and

Whereas, the naming the Stadium is an appropriate recognition for such a distinguished person;

The Schools and Libraries Cybersecurity Pilot Program will provide up to \$200 million to selected participants over a three-year term to purchase a wide variety of cybersecurity services and equipment. Pilot Program participants will be eligible to seek reimbursement for a wide variety of cybersecurity services and equipment, subject to an overall cap.

Modeled after the FCC's Connected Care Pilot, the Pilot Program will evaluate the effectiveness of using Universal Service funding to support cybersecurity services and equipment to protect school and library broadband networks and data in order to determine whether to fund them on a permanent basis.

Schools, libraries and consortia of schools and libraries (e.g., regional, or statewide groups of schools or libraries that jointly apply for the Pilot Program) that meet the E-Rate programs eligibility requirements may apply to participate in the Pilot Program. A Program applicant need not be a current or former E-Rate program applicant in order to be eligible to apply for the Pilot.

To facilitate the inclusion of a diverse set of Pilot projects and to target Pilot funds to the populations most in need of cybersecurity support, the FCC will award support to a combination of large and small and urban and rural schools, libraries, and consortia, with an emphasis on funding proposed Pilot projects that include low-income and Tribal applicants.
