Dr. Parlato gave an example of library books, and stated once she has made a decision on a challenged item, that decsion will be communicated to the Committee on Learning according to the way this regulation is written now. Should the board wish to have a say on whether a library book should stay, then a third phase would need to be added into this regulation. As of now, it ends with phase 2. The biggest concern is library books since textbook approvals are part of the curriculum proposal process. Mrs. Faulenbach asked if Dr. Parlato would add a phase 3 if the board asked for it.
