Practice at Home

- ❖ UFLI at home practice will guide you through the spelling pattern we are learning in class. Practice, practice, practice! Directions on how to use the UFLI paper are on the back of your bright green October reading log.

This Week's Agenda

Spelling: the long /i/ sound with igh, y, and ie
igh: goes primarily in the middle of a word, and is often followed by a t. There are four English words ending in 'igh' – thigh, sigh, nigh, high
ie: goes at the end of a one syllable word
Y: goes at the end of a one syllable word (it is more common than 'ie')
Reading: We will continue to read about schools around the world. This week we are learning about a new school and writing a paragraph about the problem and solution the school has overcome.
Math: We will continue discussing and investigating how to use known doubles to add and subtract near-doubles.
Science: We will investigate how seeds move to where they need to go to grow.
