CAMP CARPENTRY (9-14 yr olds)

Do you have an interest in building things and working with your hands? Enjoy planning and creating a variety of personal projects while learning basic carpentry skills during Camp Carpentry. Proper and safe use of hand tools, as well as some power tools will be highlighted as you create your projects. Projects will be suitable to take home and use.

CAMP COSMO (9-14 yr olds)

Come and explore the creative world of Cosmetology where art and science meet! You will learn how to shampoo, condition, blow dry & style manikin hair while also learning to create up-dos and braids. Manicuring and make-up application techniques on manikin masks are also included in this introduction into the exciting world of Cosmetology. The class is held at Cape May Tech's state-of-the-art Cosmetology salon.

CRIME SCENE INVESTIGATION

(Week 1: 9-11 yr olds // Week 2: 12-14 yr olds)

Ever want to be a detective - always looking to figure out who committed the crime and how? Here is your chance to put your crime solving skills to work as part of a crime scene investigation team. Get ready to investigate the crime scene, collect and analyze evidence, and finally - identify and arrest the suspect! There is a mystery out there waiting to be solved. Will you be the investigator who's up for the job? Police investigating is hard work, so come to class ready to get moving!

FUN WITH FOODS (9-14 yr olds)

Enter the world of culinary arts during *Fun With Foods!* This class covers basic food preparation with an emphasis on healthy choices. You will prepare and sample breakfasts, lunches, dinners, desserts and snacks. The program will also include recipe reading, proper measurement, care and usage of basic kitchen equipment, as well as safety and sanitation. Learn some new skills, be creative with food, and enjoy the taste of your own creations!

HAWK BASKETBALL ACADEMY (9-14 yr olds)

The Hawk Basketball Academy will promote the fundamentals of basketball with a focus on individual player development. The program will include individual and team instruction, skill-specific drills, and daily game play. This class will also aim to promote sportsmanship, scholarship, integrity, and community. Learn the fundamentals of basketball by playing the "right way!" *Students must be entering 8th grade or younger in the upcoming school year.*

MAKING THINGS GO (9-14 yr olds / wk 1 only)

Did you know that you can *make things go* by using everyday items, recycled materials and different sources of energy? Some of the projects students will build include cars that use air, battery, solar and mechanical energy sources; windmills that lift materials and create electricity; hovercrafts, basic rockets and more! Students will be given different project choices and then work to build and test their designs. At the end of the week, we'll have a rally to test projects and see how far they can go!

MARINE ADVENTURES

(Week 1: 9-11 yr olds // Week 2: 12-14 yr olds)

Embark on a sea life adventure by exploring our local salt marsh and meet its inhabitants. Discover the interesting life cycles of fish, birds, crabs, clams as well as other animals that call the salt marsh home. Learn how to catch, handle and prepare delicacies of the estuaries such as soft & hard shelled crabs, clams, oysters and fish. Other activities will include boating, constructing a crab pot, making fishing lures, learning to tie knots, seining, bird watching and eeling. This adventure takes students off the beaten path into hands-on discovery. *Dress for getting wet and muddy. Old clothes and sneakers are recommended.*

ROCKETS AND ROBOTS

(Week 1: 12-14 yr olds // Week 2: 9-11 yr olds)

Rockets and Robots will have you learning about Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM). Get ready to be engaged in hands-on activities throughout the week like building robots to test and compete, as well as building solid engine rockets. See your rocket launch before taking it home to show off!

TEAM BUILDING GAMES

(Week 1: 12-14 yr olds // Week 2: 9-11 yr olds)

Do you enjoy working on projects and playing games in groups? Do you love participating in activities during Physical Education class? Join in on some new and classic games like capture the flag, "nuke 'em," scooter races and more during Team Building Games! Be sure to bring water and a snack to stay energized!

TV BEHIND THE SCENES (9-14 yr olds)

LIGHTS! CAMERA! ACTION! TV Behind the Scenes is your chance to experience what goes on in TV production - both behind the scenes and in front of the camera. You will be the news team, the camera crew and the star of the show as students record interviews and footage of other Summertime Adventures classes.
