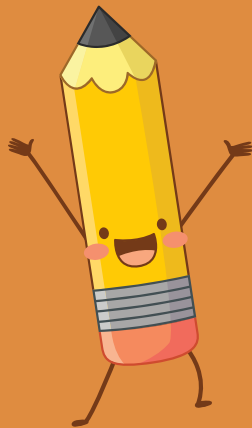

Communication

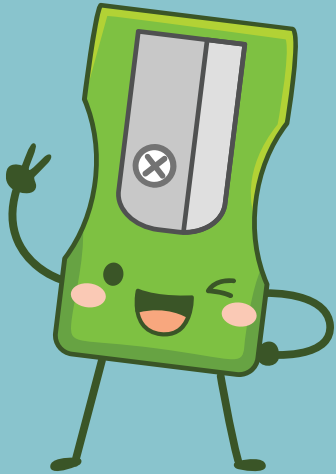
Throughout the year, we will keep you informed of things going on in the classroom and of your child's progress. This includes:

- **Parent Square**- this is our primary way of communicating with you. Check with the office if you need help setting it up. This is also where DPES admin will post school events, dates, and information.
- **Friday Folders**- this includes graded assignments for the week. Please review the graded papers, sign any sheets that are 69% or below. Return the folders on Mondays. These folders will go home every two weeks.
- **Power School**- this is the best way for you to check your student's grades.
- **Mrs. Dunkerson's Weekly Newsletter**- contains topics and test dates.

Communication Continued

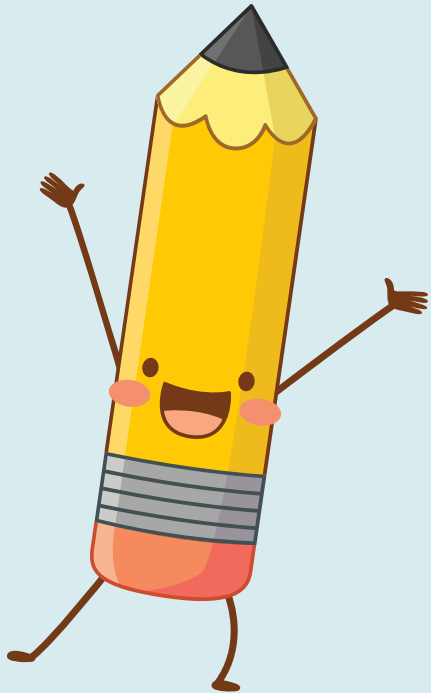
- Contact us if you have any questions or concerns.

- We expect students to always be on their best behavior. Classroom consequences are silent lunch, silent snack, or loss of Brain Break minutes.

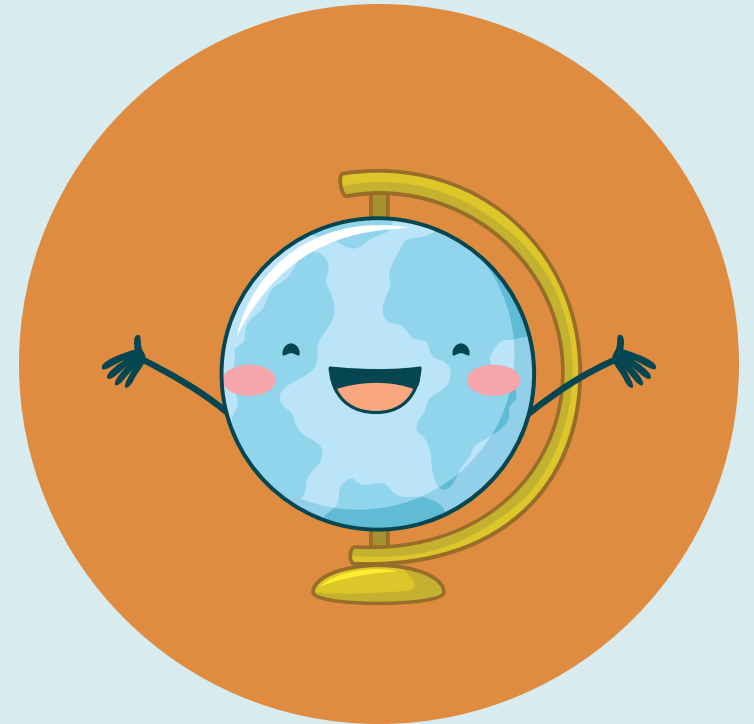
Occurrence	Consequence
1 st occurrence	Student/Teacher Conference (Warning)
2 nd occurrence	Parents will be notified by phone call of student behavior
3 rd occurrence	Parent/Teacher/Admin. Conference
4 th occurrence	Referral to Administration for Habitual Class A Behavior

*A verbal warning will be given prior to the first occurrence.

*The Behavior Management Plan starts over each semester.

School Supplies

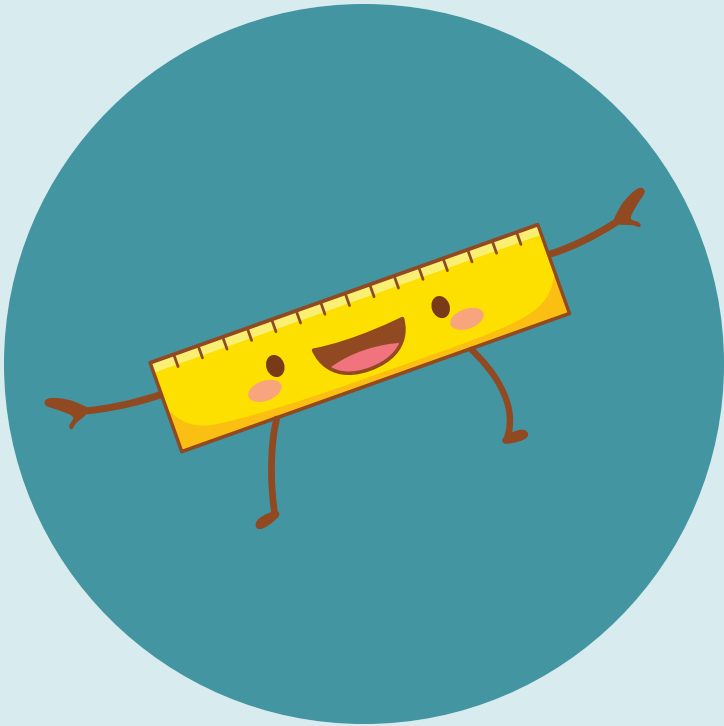
- Planners will be provided. Students are responsible for writing down all important assignments and due dates each week.
- Both classrooms have a board display showing the events and test days for the week. This information will be written down in their planner.
- School supply lists are on our website. Students will keep their personal supplies and take them to each class. Please check with your student regularly to see if they need anything replaced or replenished.
- Classroom supplies will stay with their homeroom teacher.



Water Bottles

- Students are welcome to bring their own water bottles. Water is the only drink allowed inside our classrooms.
- Students are responsible for their water bottle during transitional periods.
- Please only send water bottles with screw tops. Other cups will be left in the hallway to avoid spills in our classroom.

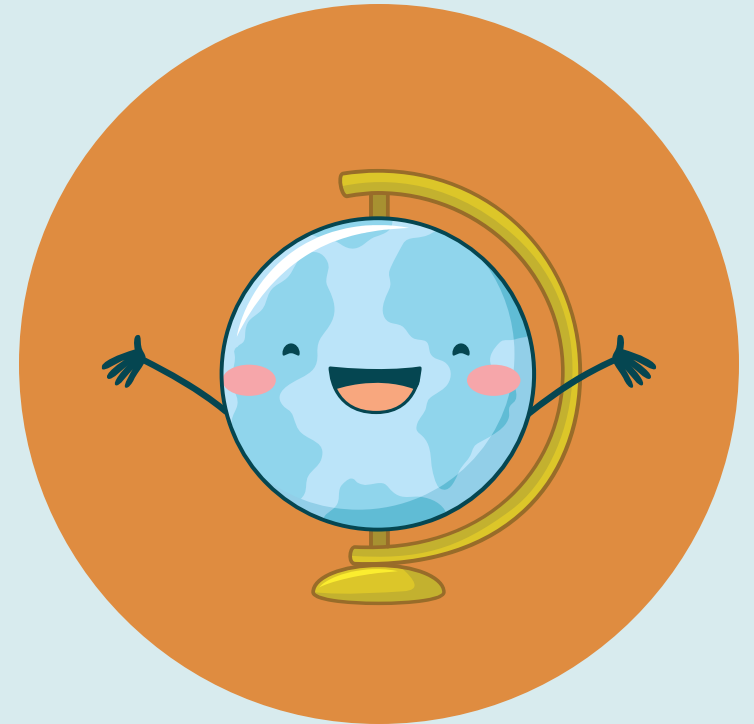
Important Info

Important Info Continued

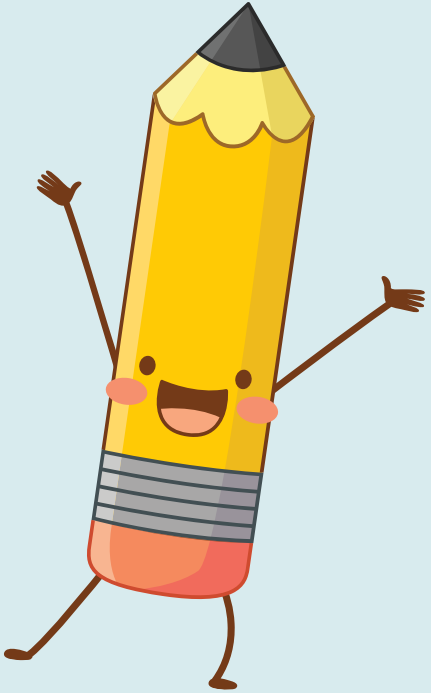

Reminders from Mr. Thornton

- Day 1: Walking child(ren) to class
 - 8-8:30am
 - Enter through the Purple Hall doors
- All deadlines for turning in money are final. No money will be accepted through the office. **Please send correct change if possible.** The school does not keep cash on hand.
- The front parking lot is closed daily until 8:00am and from 2:30-3:15pm.

Snack



- Your student is welcome to bring a snack from home or purchase one from school. We eat snack after PE each day.
- Snack can be purchased before 8:10am. The Snack Shack is located next to the lunchroom. All items are priced from \$0.25 to \$1.25
- No candy is allowed during snack time unless it is a Special Snack day.

Homework

Students are responsible for completing the homework and turning it in by the due date.

- **Reading Homework Packets**- given out each Thursday. They are due the following Thursday each week. For each day it is late, 10 points will be deducted. **They are GRADED each week.**
- **Math Homework**: given on an as need basis, usually before tests. Homework grades are a minor grade each quarter.
- Students must set time aside daily to study for spelling, science, and history tests.

Makeup Work and Attendance

- Good attendance is crucial to your student's success. Please limit absences, tardies, and check outs, if possible. **If you know in advance of an upcoming absence, please let us know.**
- Students are responsible for checking with each teacher to see what they missed when they return after being absent.
- Each classroom has a designated Makeup Work folder display.
- This work must be completed in a timely manner, with due dates being discussed with each teacher.
