What is family engagement?

How is it developed and evaluated?

This plan will be revised annually at our Title 1 meeting held in conjunction with Open House.

All students, parents, and families are encouraged and invited to participate in development, revision, and execution of this plan. Bledsoe County High School will ensure that parents and families with limited English, disabilities, and migratory children have opportunities to participate.

Where is it available?
