BUDGET GOALS SHARED

Marie Knight shared the budget goals and explained that creation of the budget is in support of the following three goals.

- 1. The district will provide the necessary instructional resources to ensure student success. Instructional resources include adequate numbers of current state adopted textbooks and updated technology to compete in a global society.
- 2. The district will maintain safe and healthy physical facilities that provide an environment for a quality learning experience.
- 3. The district will offer professional development opportunities for all employees. Through training, the staff will be expected to lead the students to higher levels of achievement.

The budget also supports the District's long term strategic plan by:

- 1. Increasing opportunities for students to graduate college and be career ready
- 2. Maintaining and improving positive relationships between all District participants
- 3. Increasing K-12 educational options, opportunities and programs
- 4. Continuing to focus on foundational instructional staffing at the elementary level
- 5. Maintain the wonderful facilities our community has provided us

PRESENTATION of BUDGET MESSAGE: Due to the absence of Superintendent Aaron Miller, BUDGET MESSAGE READ 7.0 Marie Knight read the budget message and highlighted the proposed changes to this budget from the previous year's budget.

- 4 licensed teaching positions have been added to the budget: Special Education Transition Teacher, Special Education Specialized Learning Center Teacher, and 2 Elementary Teachers
- Purchase of professional Development Programs for staff
- Increase Facility and Grounds Maintenance and Repair budgets
