The Houston County School District and Warner Robins High School would like to express our sincere congratulations to you and your graduating senior who is approaching yet another milestone on the road to adulthood. Students should arrive promptly at **4:15pm on Thursday, May 22, 2025, for graduation practice**. Practice will take place at Reaves Arena at the Georgia National Fairgrounds in Perry. Attendance at practice is mandatory. Students **will not** be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony without attending practice. This location is the same place where the graduation ceremony will be held Friday, May 23, 2025, at 4:00pm. Students should arrive promptly at 3:00pm at the designated location and line up so that they can enter the ceremony in a calm and orderly manner. Students should enter and use the North Gate Parking. Dress code standards will be strictly enforced at graduation. **Males must be in dark pants and dress shoes. Dark dress and shoes are appropriate attire for females. Any student not adhering to the dress code will not be allowed to participate in the <b>graduation ceremonies. No Shorts, No Jeans, No Tennis Shoes.** 

Because the high school graduation ceremony is usually the first formal, dignified occasion in which most teenagers participate, we would appreciate your efforts in reviewing a few points of decorum regarding this event. School administrators and teachers will address these concerns, but parental influence is much more powerful during this time of family festivity.

We need your help to ensure that the ceremony is solemn and dignified. Students should arrive promptly at the designated location and line up so that they can enter the area in a calm and orderly manner. The doors will open one hour prior to the ceremony. Please provide yourself with time to park and find your seats prior to the ceremony. The ceremony will begin promptly at 4:00pm. We ask that everyone be seated once the Processional begins. Additionally, the ceremony will be live streamed. The streaming link may be accessed on the district website, <a href="https://www.hcbe.net">www.hcbe.net</a>.

Seniors, their families, and friends should show respect for all graduates both before and after receiving diplomas. The time for celebration is after the ceremony, when students can enjoy the company of their families and friends. Any individual involved with disrupting the ceremony will be escorted from the ceremony.

Each graduate will receive **ten** tickets for their respective graduation ceremony. Graduates will be provided with additional school-specific information. We look forward to joining you in congratulating each of our graduates. This occasion is a joyous one, and we want everyone to participate in this celebration in a positive manner.
