Counselor's Corner

We are over half-way through our toolbox tools and getting better at using them every day! Here are the ones we have completed since last time:

Personal Space Tool = I have a right to my space and so do you. Our personal space "bubble" gets larger and smaller depending on how we are feeling, who is around us and what is comfortable for everyone.

Don't be a personal space invader!

Using Our Words Tool = I use the "right" words, in the "right" way, at the "right" time, for the "right" reason. Words are very powerful and can be helpful or hurtful, so think before you speak. Remember what Thumper's daddy told him, "If you can't say something nice, don't say anything at all."

Garbage Can Tool = I let the little things go. Sometimes if others are just being rude or teasing or doing things like making a mean face at you, those little things should just be thrown in the trash. Take back your control of how you react – just let the little things go and move on. Don't sweat the "small stuff".

Taking Time Tool = I take time-in and timeaway. If a situation is getting out of hand, take some time away and get some space and time to cool down. Think about how you want to respond to the person or situation to try get the resolution you want. Use your Breathing tool and your Quiet/Safe space tool to take a break and get control.
