

Hale, a senior, had 6 finishes inside the top 20 and finished 4th at regionals. He ended his DS running career with a 41st-place finish at the state meet. Osborne, also a senior, had 6 top-20 finishes this season. His best finish was 6th place at regionals. He finished 77th at the state meet, running 3 seconds faster than he did at the region meet.


