

### Spotlight on Third Grade

Our third graders have been busy growing as readers, writers, and mathematicians this month! In writing, we finished How We Know It's Fall writing and are diving into personal narratives to strengthen our writing skills! Students are learning how to grab a reader's attention with hook lines, use vivid verbs, and bring their stories to life with show don't tell strategies, onomatopoeia, and more. In reading, we're focusing on how "reading is thinking." Students are practicing important comprehension strategies such as making predictions, visualizing, and asking questions, and we'll soon begin exploring inferencing to read between the lines. In math, we've started our exciting multiplication unit! We're learning to understand multiplication conceptually and using different strategies to solve problems and explain our thinking. We're so proud of the effort and excitement our students are bringing to each subject every day!





#### Mr. Marc visits County Road School

In October, Mr. Marc from the Closter Nature Center visited our students at CRS for a fun, hands-on learning experience. The children learned about the animals he cares for, the sounds they make, how they move, and whether they are herbivores or carnivores.
