# Beginning of the Day Procedure


- Students arrive at 8:15am
  - Dropped off by main entrance- walk around the building to the playground & line up with your class when the bell rings
  - Bus riders - go to the playground & line up with your class when the bell rings
  - Walkers - go to the playground & line up with your class when the bell rings



# End of the Day Procedure

- Students who ...
  - Ride the bus will be escorted to the bus pad
  - **Walk home** will walk down the walkers' path
  - **Picked up** will meet by the benches in the front of the building (Traffic lane needs to be clear at all times.)
  - Yellow notes are issued if there are changes in a routine
  - Call if your student has a change of plans so we can meet you at the door.

# Pick up zone procedure

- 1) The “pick up” zone is the area in front of the main entrance.
- 2) Parents/guardians park their cars in any outlined parking spot in the TES, THS parking lot or in the designated zone in front of the building , not in the main traffic lane or roundabout.
- **The main roadway is to stay clear of stopped vehicles.** (Please do not form a line with your vehicle.) Parents and guardians are welcome to circle the parking lot if there is not a parking space available right away.
- 3) Students meet their parent or guardian outside of the main entrance.
- 4) Students who are picked up are **dismissed at 3:05.**



# Visitor Check-in Procedure

- The exterior doors will be locked at all times, including before the first bell.
- The office is open from 7:30am-4:00pm. Push the buzzer, introduce yourself and the office staff will assist you.
- Essential Visitors need to check in the main office and wear a visitor badge. All exterior doors are locked.
