Iron Triangle LLC is proud to offer a \$5,000 scholarship to an eligible Grant Union High School senior whose focus is directed toward Career Technical & Education schooling for heavy equipment/diesel equipment repair/operation or truck driving. To be eligible, the applicant must intend to enroll in a Career Technical & Education school, trade school, or CTE Certification program. Scholarship funds will be distributed to the school and program once enrollment has been verified.

Objective

To provide recognition of CTE students and to provide a scholarship for one or more deserving CTE students based on community service, leadership, and success in completing programs in Career & Technical Education (CTE).

Eligibility

The eligibility requirements for scholarship application, include:

- Current senior enrolled in a CTE courses offered through Grant Union High School.
- Planning to attend an institute of post-secondary learning in the fall following their senior year in high school with the focus of CTE.
- Planning to attend a vocational trade school immediately following their senior year for heavy equipment/diesel equipment repair/operation or truck driving.
- In need of financial assistance to complete schooling/program.

Required Submission Documents

Please submit the following unstapled documents:

1. Scholarship Application (typed)
2. Official transcript
3. Two letters of recommendation
4. Student Essay (typed): The student will compose a 2-page essay, double spaced, in 12-point font, with 1” margins, that describes their career goals, CTE participation, how CTE has impacted their education to prepare them for future college and/or career, and what their overarching career goals are.
