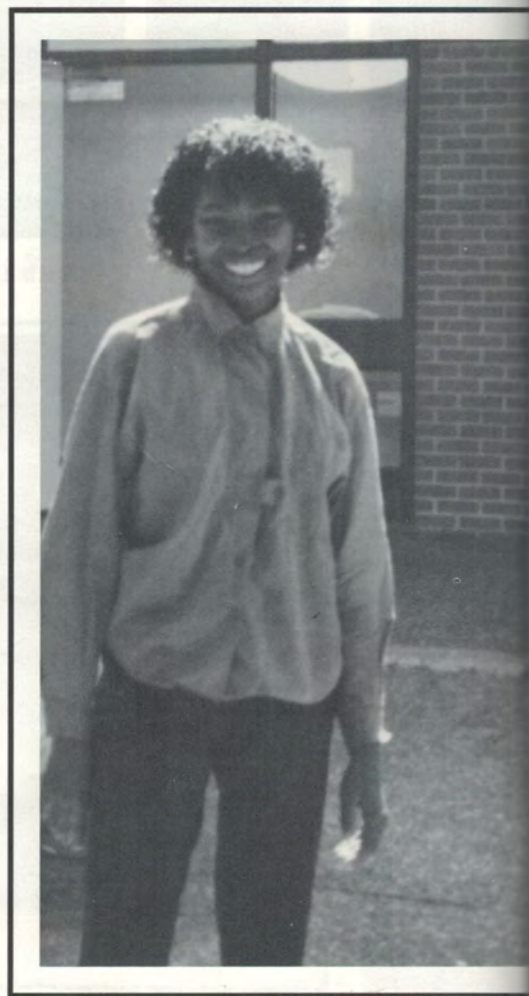
THE FRESHMEN OF 1990

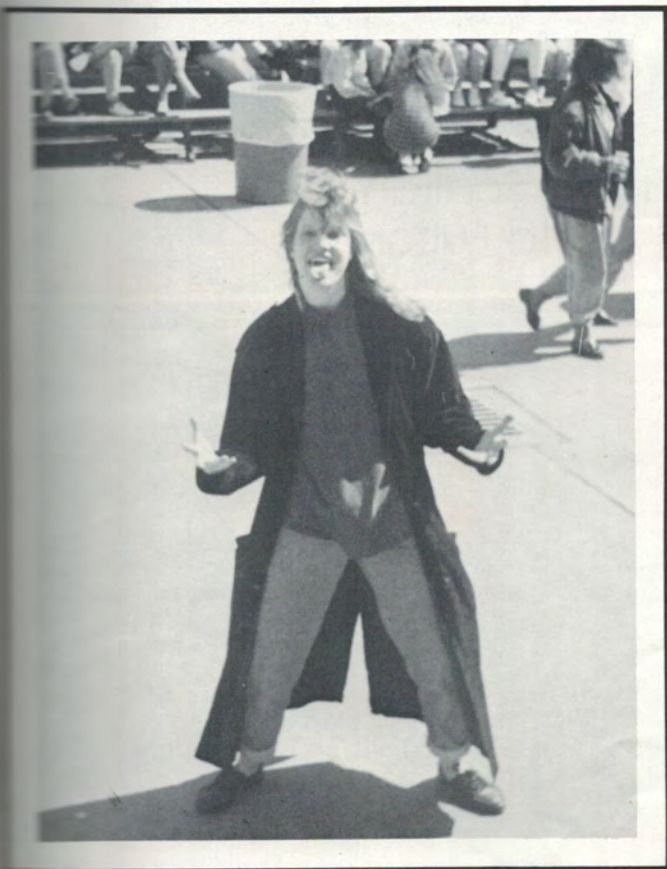
On the seventeenth of August in '89,

We seniors of '93.



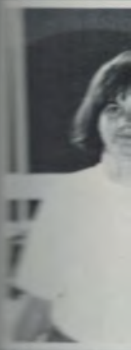

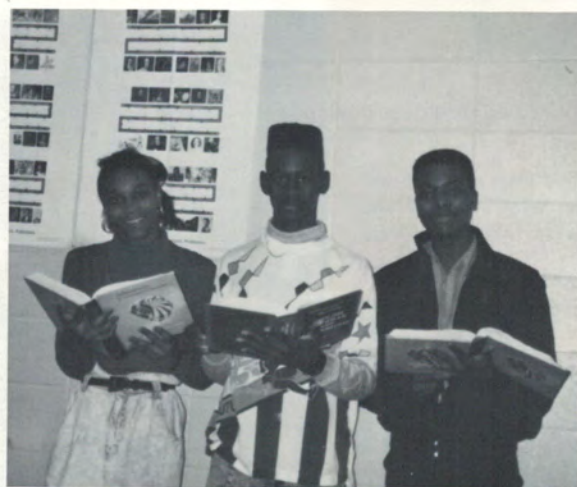
The Juniors
