New Business:

Tardy and Attendance:

- We are continuing to follow cleaning protocols including spraying

- We are currently evaluating data and continuing to try to grow and improve
- Using Chrome books for IXL to help gain ground
- Our focus is doing the little things each day to help students grow and be successful

Teacher Recruitment:

- Teacher Recruitment Fair this weekend
- At this time we have 1 Math, 1 History, 1 Science (possibly 2), and 2 ELA positions open for next year

Graduation:

- Tickets will be issued again this year as they were last year – hopefully with more tickets available as space permits
