

Congratulations to our winners!










Spotlight on 3rd Grade

- Walking to and from School-If your child walks to and/or from school, it is very important
 that you take time to speak to them about the safety protocols they should follow while
 walking. We want our students to be safe and make the right decisions. Please review the
 following protocols below:
 - Use the sidewalks where accessible
 - When crossing the street use the crosswalks and pay attention to the direction of the crossing guards
 - Make sure that your child walks directly to where they have to go whether it be home, a friend's house or if they are meeting you at a predetermined location
 - Never go anywhere with somebody that you don't know or don't trust
 - Stay away from strangers' cars and never talk to somebody you don't know
 - There should be no physical contact amongst students whatsoever
 - Do not push or touch one another even if it is for playful reasons
 - Contact while walking on the sidewalk can be very dangerous as you will be very close to the street
 - Objects such as sticks or rocks should never be picked up or thrown
 - Always be respectful of other peoples' property
 - Always refrain from using inappropriate language
