The Department of Aging and Rehabilitative Services (DARS) serves Orange, Madison, Rappahannock, and Culpeper Counties. Parents can contact DARS directly. DARS serves students ages 14 and up, as well as adults. Students can receive pre-employment supports starting in the ninth grade. DARS can do a pre-employment inventory, and provide job coaches for no cost. They can also provide work-based learning experiences, paid and unpaid-examples include animal care, law enforcement. DARS also helps students learn to advocate for themselves. Students who are a part of DARS may be eligible to attend the Woodrow Wilson Resource Center in Fishersville for job training-https://www.wwrc.virginia.gov/. DARS can help special education students get their driver's license.
