From the Principal: (Steve Campbell)

This week we started CAST testing for our science students. The format of this year's testing allows classes outside the science department to remain largely un-effected by the week's tests. There is one exception to this rule, there are a number of 11th graders (and even some 12th graders) who are required to test but do not currently have a science course. We will need to reach these students next week by bringing them into

the MMLC for their testing. These students will be contacted and brought to the MMLC with the help of our security team.

Testing seems to be going pretty well with only a few technology glitches (so far anyway) and approximately 85% of our science students having taken the science portion of the test.

English testing will be conducted the week of April 17th in a very similar format as the science. Again, most of the impact from that week's testing contained to the English Department. Math testing, also similar format, will be conducted that next week of April 24th.

We are making a much bigger push this year with our testing so please take any opportunity to help promote the importance of these tests. We are looking for a significant jump from last year's scores. I'd like to thank Tim and Leticia for putting together a game plan that seems to be off to a great start.
