Late Start Day Information

One of the most significant changes for the upcoming school year is the introduction of seven *Late Start* days, strategically scheduled throughout the year to provide educators with dedicated time for professional collaboration. These structured sessions will focus on key areas such as:

While this is a new initiative for our district, we are confident that these dedicated collaboration periods will strengthen instructional practices, optimize resources, and ultimately support student success. All *Late Start* days will take place on Mondays. On these days, the school bell schedule will follow the *2-hour Delayed Start* model.
