Mrs. Hanna's TK - 3rd Grade Class



The weather has changed! There is water falling from the sky!! Wow! On a serious note-, the seasons are changing and bringing new things to learn in our classroom.

In Language Arts we continue to learn in depth about sentences and their structure. There are different types of sentences and they have different punctuation.

In science, we are learning that all living things have different life cycles – how do tiny seeds turn into giant trees? What does it take for this to happen? Why do some plants have flowers and some plants do not have flowers? Do all plants have fruit? What is pollen and how does pollen travel?

In math, almost all the students are learning how- and getting better at subtracting! Some of the students are learning how to subtract using borrowing – do you remember when you first had to start learning this?

In social studies, we are still covering communities – there is so much to covering communities. Now we are looking at different occupations – does every community have the same occupations? What does that look like? There are some occupations that protect us, some occupations create things for us, some occupations help us & some produce things we need. All occupations are important.

It's a great time to work with these students every day!

Dear Families,

Everything is going wonderfully in our classroom, and many of our students are off to a fantastic start to the school year! We've been making steady progress across all subjects, and I'm so proud of the effort and enthusiasm I see each day.

In language arts, students are practicing their reading and writing skills and beginning to see how stories connect to their own experiences. In math, we've been sharpening our problem-solving strategies and working together to understand new concepts step by step. History and science have been especially fun and interactive—we've been telling stories, asking questions, and testing out ideas with real-world examples. The students are learning not just by listening, but by engaging, sharing, and discovering together.

Next week will be especially exciting—our chickens will be delivered! Students will take part in caring for them and learning about the entire process of raising animals, from farm to table. This hands-on experience is something I know they'll remember for years to come.

We also have some field trips coming up soon, so please keep an eye out for permission slips. We want every student to be able to participate, and your help in returning those forms on time will make that possible.

Finally, a quick reminder about homework folders. Each student should keep their folder in their backpack at all times. One side of the folder is for papers that should stay at home (like newsletters or items for you to read), while the other side is for things that need to come back to school (like permission slips and assignments). I've noticed that some students are leaving their folders at home, which means they miss opportunities to complete their homework during free time in class. Keeping the folder in the backpack at all times is the best way to stay organized and avoid missing out.

Thank you for your continued support at home—I can already tell this is going to be a great year of learning, growth, and new experiences for our students!
