Who doesn't love the extra daylight this time of year? With this surplus of rays, minus the occasional day of blistering heat slowing efforts, the building crews around campus are hard at work pushing various facility improvement projects forward.

The efforts are bearing results in the Ad Building with its interior completely opened-up with tuck pointed brick and limestone work complete. Currently, fire suppression system installation on the garden and main levels and a forthcoming garden to third-floor custom-designed staircase installation are the last significant steps before finish-work such as drywalling, drop ceiling, and carpeting may commence.

With the volleyball team beginning pre-season conditioning, the athletes will step foot onto a crisp re-finished court in the gymnasium. Specifically, the hardwood is now equipped with a fresh eagle logo, brand new lines, and a re-finishing that will amplify sneakers squeaking during dreaded rounds of lines. Beyond the court, the new addition in the Gym Building will be open just in time for the advent of the new school year. This includes the completed fire suppression system, the utility room that houses it, an additional storage room, family bathroom, and a hallway connecting the new restrooms to the locker room hallway. The openness, freshness, and additional space await guests this fall.

With this Gym Building addition concluding, the sole focus is now the new kitchen and dining hall. Worn and weathered, these facilities have served countless meals and been the host for so many meaningful interactions, but the time is here, and the need is very real for a complete overhaul. It will help equip our amazing staff with a new kitchen and provide our students with a renewed space for dining and community building? As of now, the current need is approximately \$1.5 million. Budget Corner




