Dear Parishioners,

Tuesday is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is a Holy Day of Obligation, and we will have Masses in the evening of Monday at St. Eloi (with a supper following) and Tuesday at St. Edward. I hope many can attend and praise God for what He has done for our Blessed Mother.

The Assumption is not just about the Virgin. Yes, we celebrate her transition into heaven, body, and soul. But her assumption is the model for our eternal life – that we will be in heaven, body, and soul. The Blessed Mother enjoys her eternal life perfectly with body and soul because of the Incarnation – that the Son of God took on flesh through her.

God did not allow corruption to pollute her body, and so is preserved and transformed into the resurrected body already. We, on the other hand, will suffer corruption. Our bodies will fail and decay. But we who are faithful live in the hope of resurrection and eternal life – and as human beings, that means body and soul as we are embodied souls and ensouled bodies.

Next week is the start of the new school year (already) I hope and pray that it will be a blessed year for all our students and teachers. As we prepare for this year, I will offer a student and teacher blessing at the end of the Masses next weekend.

Give us the eyes of faith to recognize His presence in our brothers and sisters, especially in the face of the poor and the suffering.


Nourished by the Eucharist, send us forth to walk faithfully as missionary disciples, proclaiming the Gospel to every heart and extending Your kingdom to every land.


