Standards-

Reading/Writing

2. Identify coins by name and value

Science

1. explain how humans mimic plants and animals to solve problems
2. identify patterns of behavior in parents and offspring that help offspring survive

1. Identify basic needs such as food, clothing, and shelter and how people meet those needs
2. Identify the difference between wants and needs
