ESTABLISHMENT OF VENDORS LIST FOR DIESEL FUEL AND GASOLINE

PERRY COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

The Perry County School System will purchase gasoline and diesel fuel from an established vendors list for the 2026-2027 School year. Each vendor must complete the registration forms and turn them in by 10.a.m. May 14th, 2026, in order to be on the vendor list.

When diesel fuel and/or gasoline is needed, the district buyer will contact all approved vendors for price quotes. Quantity to order and location of delivery points will be stated, and bids will be entered on the prescribed form. The bid will be awarded to the lowest bidder who is capable of making delivery to the prescribed location within the required time. This is considered to be 3:00 p.m. the second day following the order, or Monday following a Friday order.

Driver's will contact a school representative prior to unloading so that storage tank contents may be measured before and after delivery of the product.

Diesel fuel and gasoline specifications will be in accordance with the Kentucky Minimum Specifications for School Buses. A copy of this document is attached and is considered to be a part of the vendor's agreement to provide diesel fuel and gasoline which meets or exceeds the specifications.

Kentucky school districts should purchase blended fuel at the time of the year when the ambient temperature averages 20° or less. Blends are designed to reduce the problem of diesel fuel gel.

RECOMMENDED BLENDS:

25 percent number 1 diesel fuel 75 percent number 2 diesel fuel.

GASOLINE FUEL SPECIFICATIONS FOR SCHOOL BUS
TRANSPORTATION

Manufactures/Suppliers shall be required to furnish to the purchasing school district of gasoline fuel for student transportation usage gasoline fuel that meets the following minimum standards:

(1) VOLATILITY STANDARD:

S.AE J312d Volatility Index for Kentucky

(2) GRADE:

Regular, Premium Unleaded, Unleaded, It shall be the individual purchaser's responsibility to determine the fuel grade to be purchased,

(3) OCTANE:

Minimum 89. It shall be the individual purchaser's responsibility to determine specific octane requirements for vehicles in use and shall state any octane in excess of the referenced standard as part of their bid document.

(4) OCTANE ENHANCEMENT

Alcohol will not be accepted as octane enhancer. The supplier of fuel shall certify by document to the purchasing school district the octane octane enhancer being provided before bid award and at each fuel delivery.

(5) FUEL MANUFACTURER QUALIFICATION:

Only gasoline fuels manufactured by manufacturing concerns who are current members .in good standing of the American Petroleum Institute shall be approved for the sale of gasoline fuel for use in student transportation vehicles.

(6) CERTIFICATIONS OF GASOLINE FUEL:

(1) All suppliers of gasoline fuel shall certify to the purchasing school district their ability to furnish gasoline fuel in qualities needed in accordance with the aforereferenced specifications prior to bid award.

(2) Gasoline manufacturers and suppliers shall jointly certify to the purchasing school district certification documents prior to bid award stating that the gasoline fuels to be furnished meet all of the aforereferenced specifications

(3) The supplier of gasoline fuel shall .certify by document to the purchasing school district that gasoline fuel at the time of each delivery prior to transferring gasoline fuel into storage tanks meets minimum requirements of the aforereferenced specification.

A. ACCEPTANCE OF BIDS

The Board of Education reserves the right to accept any bid, to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularities or informalities in bids received where such acceptance, rejection or waiver is considered to be in its best interest. The Board of Education also reserves the right to reject any bid where evidence or information submitted by the bidder does not provide satisfactory proof that the bidder is qualified to carry out the details of the contract.

B. BID DOCUMENTS

Bid forms are provided with this "Invitation to Bid". All proposals must be submitted on the "Bid Form".

C. SPECIFICATIONS

Specifications are attached and are a part of this proposal. All materials or services furnished must be in conformity with the specifications and will be subject to inspection and approval of the Purchasing Agent after delivery. The right is reserved to reject and return at the risk and expense of the supplier, any item which may be defective or fail to comply with these specifications.

It is important that each person submitting a bid follow carefully the specifications detailed herewith. The bidder is instructed to complete all blanks and spaces where information concerning any item is requested. Only items meeting the requirements are to be quoted on the regular bid form.

E. PERFORMANCE BOND

The Board of Education reserves the right to determine the ability of any bidder to perform the work, and any bidder shall, upon request, furnish such information as may be necessary to determine such ability, including performance bond, if requested. F. EXCUSE FOR NON-PERFORMANCE

The successful vendor(s) shall be excused from performing hereunder during the time and to the extent that they are prevented from obtaining, delivering or performing in the customary way because of fire, strike, partial or total interruption of, loss or shortage of transportation facilities, lockout, commandeering of raw materials, products, plants or facilities by the government when satisfactory evidence thereof is presented to the other party, providing it is satisfactorily established that the non-performance is not due to the fault of negligence of the party not performing.

G. PENALTIES

In case of default by the vendor, The Board of Education may procure the articles or services from other sources and may deduct from any unpaid balance due the vendor the amount of the excess cost so paid, and the price paid shall be considered the prevailing market price at the time such purchase is made.

H. TAXES

The Federal Excise Tax and Kentucky Sales and Use Tax are not to be imposed as the Board of Education will furnish the successful bidder with proper tax exemption certificates upon request.

I. PRODUCT EVALUATION

Items will be disqualified that do not meet specifications or the accepted equal. If a product is purchased and it is later established that said product fails to comply with these specifications and conditions, the item will be rejected and returned to the supplier at the supplier's expense. No item shall be considered satisfactory that does not conform to our usual accepted methods, use, application, storage, handling and delivery.
