- Updated Immunization Records for ALL new students to Burns Middle School

If you would like your student to have anything in particular you are more than welcome to purchase it.

Each teacher may request additional items.

Dear Parent/Guardian:

As we prepare for the 2022-2023 school year, we want to remind you of items you may need to present to your child's school.

- 1) If you have moved to a new address OR
- 2) If your child has never attended an MCPSS school OR
- 3) If your child will be attending a different school than he/she attended during the 2021-2022 school year, please go to the school's website for instructions regarding providing the following proofs:
 - Your Current lease, mortgage statement, deed, property tax statement, housing contract
 - Your Current utility bill associated with that property address (power, water, gas)
 - Legal guardian's ID
- **Please check your school's website for procedures on how to provide your proofs of residence**
 - 4) If you are in one of the following situations, you will need to complete a <u>RESIDENCE ASSESSMENT FORM</u> (see instructions on page 2):
 - Living temporarily with a friend or relative due to loss of housing, eviction, economic hardship, or similar reason
 - Living in RV parks OR camping grounds due to lack of adequate alternative accommodations
 - Living in emergency or transitional shelters
 - Living in a public or private place not designed for humans to live
 - Living in vehicles, parks, abandoned buildings, bus or train stations, etc.
 - Migratory children living in the above circumstances

- Unaccompanied Youth ~ child or youth NOT in the physical custody of parent/guardian
- Parent/guardian is recently deceased or incarcerated
- Parent/guardian is on military deployment and another person has to enroll child
- Student is placed by DHR, Court or agency with someone other than legal parent/guardian
- Staying in a motel/hotel or a pay-by-the-week establishment.

IF one of these circumstances above applies to you, please be prepared to produce the following documentation:

- Your ID and the ID of the person you are living with (person who owns/rents the property)
- 2 proofs of residence from the person(s) you are living with: one proof <u>MUST</u> be a current lease, mortgage statement, deed, property tax statement or housing contract and the second proof <u>MUST</u> be a current utility bill (i.e. power, water, gas) associated with the property address.
- Any official mail/bills coming to that residence/address in the parent/guardian's name (example: hospital bill, government assistance letter, etc.)
- If you are living in a motel/hotel or a pay-by-the-week establishment, you will need a CURRENT rent receipt with the name of the establishment

This form is available throughout the school year for any circumstances listed above.
