Special Meeting/Public Hearing – June 19, 2025

The Stark County Community Unit School District #100 Board of Education met for a Special Meeting and Public Hearing on Thursday, June 19, 2025, at the Stark County Elementary School cafeteria. Members present were Emily Leezer, Ann Orwig, Dane Richards, and Bruce West. Erin Price, Joseph Rediger, and Chelsea Streitmatter were absent. Also present were Brett Elliott, Superintendent, and a member of the press.

With a quorum present, President Orwig called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

President Orwig opened a public hearing on the proposed Amended Budget for Fiscal Year 2025. Superintendent Elliott presented an overview of the amendments to be made including a Fund 40, \$50,000 increase in revenues due to the receipt of funds from the Bus to Grid Grant. Expenditure adjustments include a Fund 10 decrease of \$18,000 to reduce superintendent expenses in order to meet state administrative cap guidelines. Fund 40 expenditures were adjusted by a total increase of \$127,745 to reflect the Bus to Grid Outlay expense (related to the increase in revenues), increase in special education bus route salary and insurance benefits, increased capital outlay for vehicle balance and garage door opener, as well as bus lease return expenses. Fund 50 had some small adjustments within subcategories. The Purchased Services line in Fund 60 expenditures was increased due to excess funds (interest). President Orwig opened the hearing for public comments.

Seeing no public comments, President Orwig closed the public hearing.

Motion was made by Mr. West and seconded by Mrs. Leezer to approve the Amended Budget for Fiscal Year 2025 as presented. Motion passed with a 4-0 vote.
