GUIDELINES FOR EARLY DISMISSAL & LATE ARRIVAL

Early dismissal and late arrival is a privilege awarded to seniors only. Rocky Hill High School continues to be a closed campus for students, meaning students cannot leave and then return to campus during the school day. Parents have the option to allow their senior to arrive late to school and/or leave early from school on days when they do not have a scheduled class during the first or last period. Students must adhere to the following guidelines:

- 1. Seniors who do not have any assigned period 1 class may arrive immediately prior to the start of homeroom (8:20 a.m.)
- 2. All students may leave immediately at the end of their scheduled classes. They may <u>not</u> return until the end of the school day if they are involved in sports or other school-sponsored activities.
- 3. Students are expected to follow all school rules and regulations. Students reported causing a problem in school, on school grounds, or in the community during the late arrival or early dismissal period will lose the privilege.
- 4. Students are responsible for their own transportation.

5. SPECIAL NOTES:

- All students must apply <u>each semester</u>.
- Tardiness may result in the loss of this privilege.
- Schedules will <u>not</u> be changed for the purpose of this privilege.
- Requests for these privileges must be in writing and must include the signatures of the student and parent/guardian.
- Students who attempt to circumvent the regulations (i.e. have excessive parent-authorized dismissals, have excessive tardies to school, etc) will be subject to review by administration with possibility of being disqualified for the late arrival/early dismissal privileges.
- School administration has the right to revoke this privilege for failing to comply with the Board of Education and RHHS handbook school code of conduct at any time.
