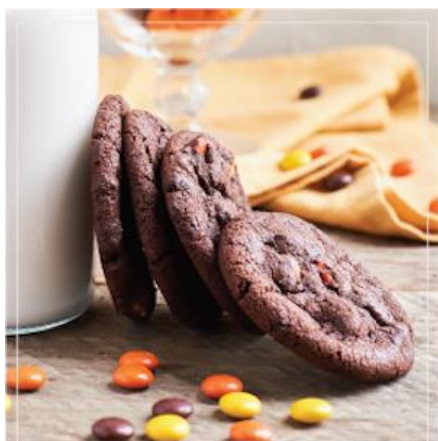

Dress Code Reminder – Shoes and Socks

- **Socks PK3 through Grade 8:** solid color white, black, or navy blue socks; no ruffles
 - **Shoes PK3 through Grade 2:** athletic shoes with non-scuff heels of a light color may be worn during the school day. Boots, high tops, sandals are not permitted.
 - **Shoes Grades 3 through 8:** solid black, dark brown or navy blue dress shoes that are cut below the ankle and are totally enclosed. **NOT permitted:** athletic shoes, boots, high tops, sandals, or canvas shoes.
 - **PE Shoes Gr.3-8:** athletic shoes with non-scuff heels of a light color
