

Please see the following scholarship announcement regarding class of 2024 students who plan to or are already attending an Alabama community college (like LBWCC) and are in a program associated with automotive manufacturing careers.

MONTGOMERY – Scholarships are available to residents interested in attending one of Alabama’s community colleges to train for careers in the state’s automotive manufacturing industry. The scholarships are the result of a partnership between the [Alabama Automotive Manufacturers Association](#) (AAMA) and the Alabama Community College System (ACCS).

Funding is available to award additional \$4,000 scholarships to students who are enrolled in a program at an Alabama community college that is associated with automotive manufacturing careers. Interested high school seniors, residents interested in attending college, and current college students with at least a 2.5 GPA can learn more information and apply directly through the website, www.dreamitdoitalabama.com/aama/. **The deadline to apply is Thursday, March 28, 2024.**

Students who are awarded the scholarship may use the funds for their summer or fall 2024 tuition, books, and fees associated with the approved program of study. A full submission for the scholarship requires the following: a completed application; completion of a new orientation course to the automotive industry and AAMA scholarship; one signed reference letter; an unofficial college or high school transcript; a resume; an essay; and a headshot photo.

Programs in which applicants can use the scholarship include the following: Mechatronics; Automated Manufacturing Technology; Industrial Electronics Technology; Industrial Maintenance Technology; Manufacturing Technology; Machining/Machine Tool/CNC; Automotive Service Technology; and Engineering Technology.
