By looking at you, will they see what being a Christ follower really means? Will you rise to the occasion and pour out your life in order to bring healing to others?

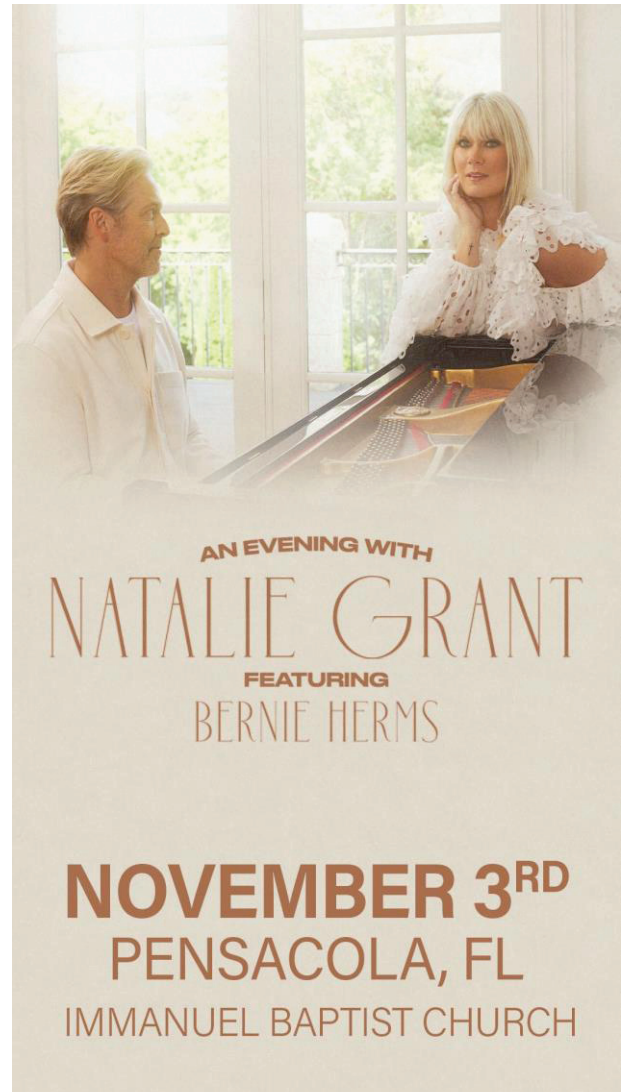

Power 88 will also be there to encourage you. Your brothers and sisters in Christ will stand with you. Go ahead. Dare to make that great decision.

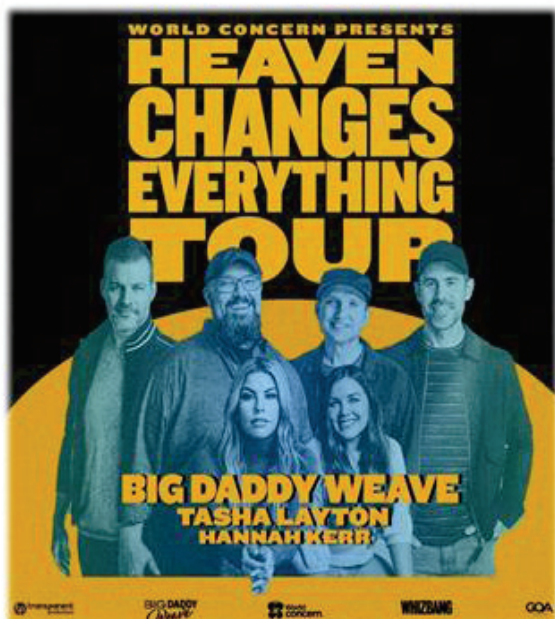
