

Frequently Asked Home School Questions

What Districts Provide

- Question:** Are school districts required to provide home schooled students with instructional textbooks and materials?
- Answer:** State law does not require districts to provide home-schooled students with textbooks and instructional materials. The local school district may, however, provide home-schooled students with materials such as books.
- Question:** Are home-schooled students allowed to participate in extra-curricular activities such as team sports, football, or school clubs?
- Answer:** Yes. Act 203, the Equal Access to Interscholastic Activities Act, permits home-schooled students to participate in extra-curricular and interscholastic activities after statutorily-required conditions are met.

State Testing for Home-Schooled Students

- Question:** Are home-schooled students required to participate in the statewide testing programs approved by the State Board of Education for their appropriate grade levels?
- Answer:** Students who are home schooled under Option One must participate in the annual statewide testing program. The tests must be administered by a certified school district employee either with public school students or by special arrangement at the student's place of instruction, at the parent's option. Students who are not home schooled in district approved programs are not eligible to take those assessments.

Credit for Courses

- Question:** Do home-schooled students in grades 7–12 receive high school credit for any courses that they pass?
- Answer:** Home-schooled students in grades 7–12 receive credits from their home school program. These credits would show on the transcript that is maintained by the parent or the association. **Those credits, however, are not automatically accepted by other public or private schools.**
- Question:** Can home-schooled students earn and receive credit for courses taken through the South Carolina Virtual School Program?
- Answer:** Home schooled students may earn credit through the South Carolina Virtual School Program if they meet the guidelines of that program.

High School Diplomas

- Question:** Do students who are home schooled and who complete high school receive a South Carolina High School Diploma?
- Answer:** No, only accredited public South Carolina high schools issue a South Carolina high school

diploma.

Question: Do students who are home schooled and complete high school receive a “South Carolina Home-Schooled Diploma”?

Answer: There is no “official” home school diploma. Home school “diplomas” are issued by the parent or in some cases the home school association.

Home-Schooled Student Returns to Public School

Question: If home-schooled students return to public school, will they automatically start in the classes or at grade levels the home school teacher/parents say that they have completed?

Answer: If home-schooled students return to a South Carolina public school district, the district has the right to place the students in classes/grade levels which the district/school deems is instructionally appropriate for the students. In other words, because parents tell the district that the students have completed certain grade levels, does not mean the students will be placed into the next grade level. *(District instructional placement of returning home-schooled students is usually based on some type of test results that the district determines.)*

Other Questions

Question: Does the South Carolina Department of Education (SCDE) accredit any of the home schools listed on the SCDE’s Web site?

Answer: No. The SCDE does not accredit any home school association.

Question: Does the South Carolina Department of Education (SCDE) recommend or endorse any of the home schools listed on the SCDE’s Web site?

Answer: No. The SCDE does not have the authority to approve or endorse any of the home school associations listed on the department’s Web site. Each home school association on the Web site has submitted the Annual Standards Assurance form ensuring, at a minimum, that the association has met the requirements stated in S.C. Code Ann. *S. C. Code Ann. 59-65-45 and § 59-65-47*

Question: Does the South Carolina Department of Education (SCDE) monitor home schooling?

Answer: No. However, the SCDE requests that home school associations contact Peggy Scott in the Office of Federal and State Accountability at 803-734-4040 to complete the Annual Standards Assurance form required under S.C. Code Ann. § 59-65-47 and 59-65-45.

Each home school association listed on the SCDE Web site has submitted the Annual Standards Assurance form ensuring, at a minimum, that the association has met the requirements stated in S.C. Code Ann. *59-65-45 and § 59-65-47*.



Home-Schooling Application

SECTION 59-65-40. Home schooling programs. (OPTION 1)

(A) Parents or guardians may teach their children at home if the instruction is approved by the district board of trustees of the district in which the children reside. A district board of trustees shall approve home schooling programs which meet the following standards:

(1) the parent:

(a) holds at least a high school diploma or the equivalent general educational development (GED) certificate and, beginning in the 1989-90 school year, attains a passing score on the basic skills examination developed pursuant to Section 59-26-20(b)(1) after the State Department of Education has validated the test for use with home schooling parents;

or

(b) has earned a baccalaureate degree;

(2) the instructional day is at least four and one-half hours, excluding lunch and recesses, and the instructional year is at least one hundred eighty days;

(3) the curriculum includes, but is not limited to, the basic instructional areas of reading, writing, mathematics, science, and social studies and in grades seven through twelve, composition and literature;

(4) as evidence that a student is receiving regular instruction, the parent shall present a system for maintaining and maintain the following records for inspection upon reasonable notice by a representative of the school district:

(a) a plan book, diary, or other written record indicating subjects taught and activities in which the student and parent engage;

(b) a portfolio of samples of the student's academic work; and

(c) a record of evaluations of the student's academic progress. A semiannual progress report including attendance records and individualized assessments of the student's academic progress in each of the basic instructional areas specified in item (3) must be submitted to the school district.

(5) students must have access to library facilities;

(6) students must participate in the annual statewide testing program and the Basic Skills Assessment Program approved by the State Board of Education for their appropriate grade level. The tests must be administered by a certified school district employee either with public school students or by special arrangement at the student's place of instruction, at the parent's option. The parent is responsible for paying the test administrator if the test is administered at the student's home; and

(7) parents must agree in writing to hold the district, the district board of trustees and the district's employees harmless for any educational deficiencies of the student sustained as a result of home instruction.

(A) At any time the school district determines that the parent is not maintaining the home school program in keeping with the standards specified in this section the district board of trustees shall notify the parent to correct the deficiencies within thirty days. If the deficiencies are not corrected within thirty days, the district board of trustees may withdraw its approval.

(B) The district board of trustees shall provide for an application process which elicits the information necessary for processing the home schooling request, including a description of the program, the texts and materials to be used, the methods of program evaluation, and the place of instruction. Parents must be notified in advance of the date, place, and time of the meeting at which the

application is considered by the board and parents may be heard at the meeting.

(C) Within the first fifteen instructional days of the public school year, students participating in home instruction and eligible for enrollment in the first grade of the public schools must be tested to determine their readiness for the first grade using the readiness instrument approved by the State Board of Education for public school students. If a student is determined to be "not ready" or is determined to lack the necessary emotional maturity, the parent must be advised by appropriate school district personnel whether a kindergarten or a first grade curriculum should be used for the child. Nothing in this section may be interpreted to conflict with a parent's right to exempt his child from kindergarten as provided in Section 59-65-10(A).

(D) Should a student in a home schooling program score below the test requirements of the promotion standard prescribed for public school students by the State Board of Education for one year, the district board of trustees shall decide whether or not the student shall receive appropriate instructional placement in the public school, special services as a handicapped student, or home schooling with an instructional support system at parental expense. The right of a parent to enroll his child in a private or parochial school as provided in Section 59-65-10(A) is unaffected by this provision.

(E) If a parent is denied permission to begin or continue home schooling by a district board of trustees, the decision of the district board of trustees may be appealed, within ten days, to the State Board of Education. Any appeal from the decision of the State Board of Education must be taken, within thirty days, to the family court.

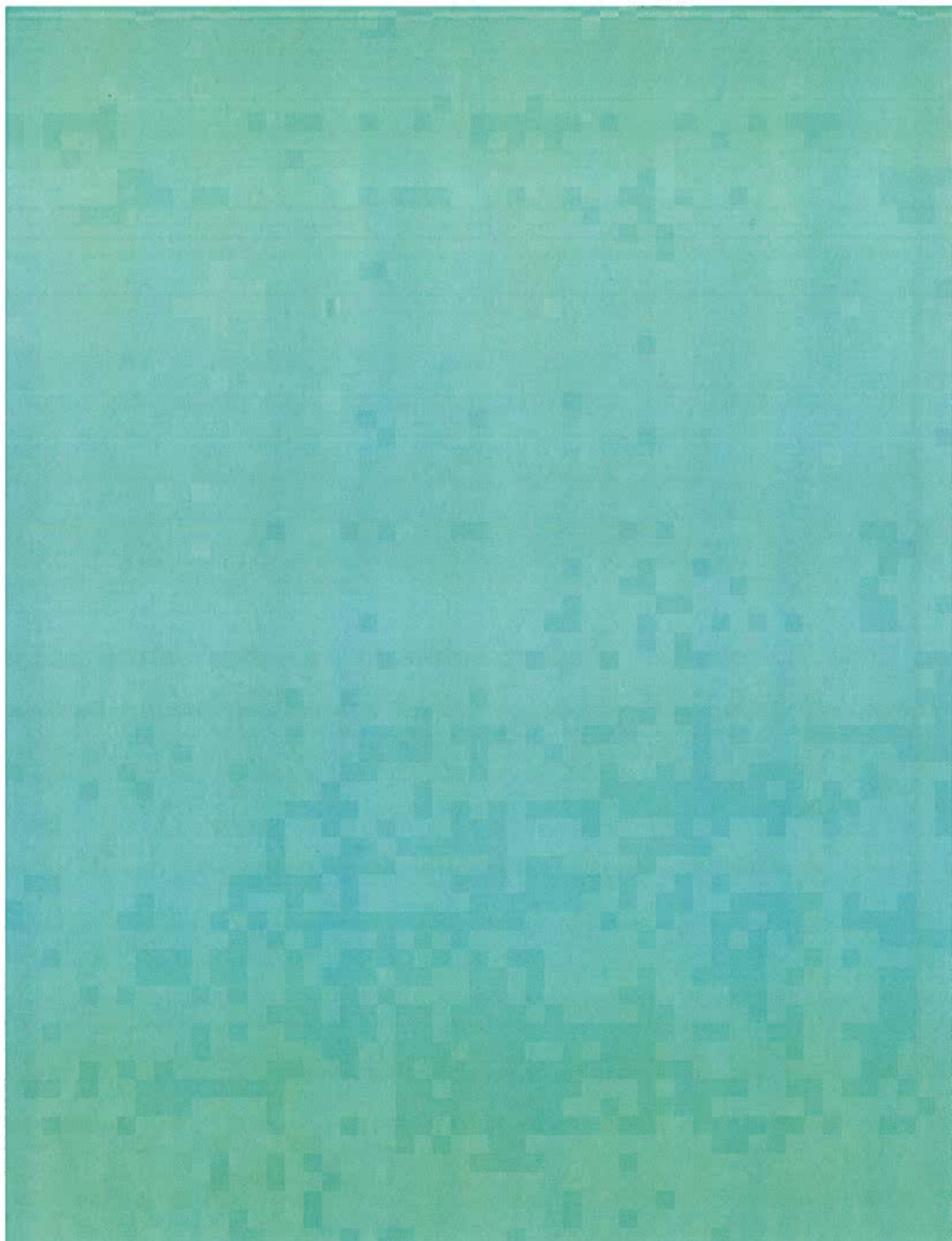
