1. symbiosis: the close, and often helpful, association of two living beings that are not alike				
2. <u>scurry</u> : to go or move in a hurry				
3. <u>liquid</u> : a form of matter that is not a solid or a gas				
4. <b>partner</b> : a person who joins or shares with another				
5. <u>shelter</u> : something that covers or protects				
6. <u>relationship</u> : a connection between two or more things				
7. <u>honeydew</u> : a sweet substance secreted on leaves and stems by aphids and certain other plant- sucking insects				
8. predators: an animal, such as a wolf, lion, or hawk, that lives by preying on other animals				
9. <u>colony</u> : a group of animals or plants of the same kind that live together				
10. <b>team</b> : a group that plays, acts, or works together				
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
