Requirements for Scholarship:

- ***A Graduating Senior from Northside High School going to college.***
- ***Scholarship application must include the following:***
 - the application***
 - the letter of college intent or copy of acceptance letter***
 - a letter of recommendation from the Drama Teacher of Northside High School***
 - a second letter of recommendation from another Northside teacher***
 - a non-returnable senior picture***
- ***Applicant must have participated in the Drama Program at Northside High School in at least one of the following areas: on stage, behind the scenes, set design/construction, make-up, costume, lighting or sound.***
- ***The Application will be reviewed by the Executive Board members.***
- ***This scholarship will not be awarded based on grades.***
- ***This scholarship program will exhibit a nondiscriminatory selection process.***
- ***The recipient must be elected by a two-thirds vote of the Board.***
- ***The recipient of the Ray Horne Scholarship will be announced during Northside's Senior Awards program by the President of the Executive Board.***
- ***The awarding of the scholarship will be made in the recipient's name and paid directly to their college/university.***
- ***A plaque will be placed in the lobby of the Ray Horne Theatre for Performing Arts listing the annual recipient.***
